Africa: Various states participate at the Diplomatic Conference on Genetic Resources and Associated Traditional Knowledge in Geneva $^{1\ 2\ 3}$

Various delegates from African countries participated at the Diplomatic Conference on Genetic Resources and Associated Traditional Knowledge in Geneva, Switzerland from 13-24 May 2024. This conference was held to protect the rights of indigenous communities and promote fairness, equity, and sustainability in their global utilization. The aim of the conference was to establish a treaty for the protection of genetic resources and traditional knowledge.

Africa: WIPO Member States Adopt Historic New Treaty on Intellectual Property, Genetic Resources and Associated Traditional Knowledge⁴

On 24 May 2024, the WIPO member states approved a new treaty relating to Intellectual Property, Genetic Resources and Associated Traditional Knowledge. Once the treaty enters into force with 15 contracting parties, it will establish a new disclosure requirement for patent applicants whose inventions are based on genetic resources and/or associated traditional knowledge.

Ghana: Ghana joins TMClass⁵

Effective from 13 May 2024, the Registrar General's Department of Ghana will use and accept the terms of the harmonized database of goods and service (HDB) in TMClass. There are now 34 IP Office outside of the European Union using and accepting the terms of this database. The total number of participating national and regional offices now stands at 93.

Morocco: The Saudi Authority for Intellectual Property and the Moroccan Industrial and Commercial Property Office Launch PPH Pilot Program⁶

On 24 April 2024, the Saudi Authority for Intellectual Property ("SAIP") and the Moroccan Industrial and Commercial Property Office ("OMPIC") jointly announced the launch of a pilot program for the Patent Prosecution Highway ("PPH"). The PPH allows examination results from partnering offices to be utilized thereby streamlining the patent applications process between the respective offices thereby accelerating the grant of patents.

OAPI: E-Filing Process to Commence From 3 June 2024⁷

Implementation of the OAPI e-filing system will commence on 3 June 2024. The e-filing system will be implemented for trade mark matters including registrability searches, filing of applications, renewals, Recordals and oppositions. Patent matters will not be part of the initial stage, but company name registrations and objects will also be managed by the e-filing system soon.

Sudan: Counterfeit and Expired Medicines Sold on Sudan Markets⁸

In early May 2024, a warning was issued by the Sudan's National Council for Drugs and Toxins regarding unknown packaging of Amidol 500mg tablets used as a painkiller. This warning refocused the attention on the nearly complete cessation of the local pharmaceutical industry and the problem of smuggled and counterfeit medicines in war-torn Sudan.

Tunisia: MPs start considering bill on Tunisia's accession to amended protocol to WTO Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights⁹

On 29 May 2024, members of Parliament started a plenary discussion session to consider the organic bill 2023/51 which approves the accession to the amended protocol to WTO TRIPS agreement. More particularly, the bill provides for the approval of the amendment on the provisions of the protocol on patents.
