#### Africa: Africa IPSME Helpdesk offers free first-line IP assistance service for European SMEs<sup>1,2</sup>

The EUIPO, as part of the EU-funded #AfricaIPSMEHelpdesk initiative, now offers FREE first-line IP assistance to European SMEs operating or planning to access the African market. SMEs can send their IP questions and receive a customized response from IP experts within 3 working days. # Ethiopia: The Council of Ministers approves the Paris Industrial Property Convention draft proclamation to the House of Representatives<sup>3,4</sup>

The Council of Ministers in Ethiopia has approved two draft bills related to international treaties on industrial property protection and trademark registration. The first bill concerns Ethiopia's accession to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, which mandates member countries to provide protection for various types of intellectual property such as patents, trademarks, industrial designs, and more. Adopting this treaty is seen as a step toward Ethiopia's goal of joining the World Trade Organization (WTO), helping address WTO member countries' concerns about industrial property protection. The second bill pertains to the Madrid Protocol, which facilitates the international registration and protection of trademarks. This law aims to provide a legal framework for Ethiopian businesses to protect their trademarks globally. Both bills were passed by the Council and are now set to be reviewed and ratified by the Ethiopian parliament.

## Kenya: Integration with eCitizen Payment Gateway Complete<sup>5</sup>

The Anti-Counterfeit Authority (ACA) has completed its integration with the eCitizen payment gateway, in line with a presidential directive on government service payments. As a result, all ACA import permit applications must now be submitted via the Trade Facilitation Platform (TFP) at https://tfp.kenyatradenet.go.ke, which supports payments through the eCitizen gateway. Additionally, ACA's Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) recordation services, including applications for recording, renewing, or transferring IPR, as well as other related services, can now be paid through eCitizen. ACA's enforcement services, including fines and applications for various actions (e.g., compounding offenses, seizure of counterfeit goods, inspections, etc.), are also payable via M-Pesa Pay bill 222 222. A detailed fee structure

#### Namibia: Appointment of Ainna V. Kaundu as new Acting CEO<sup>6</sup>

On October 21, 2024, it was announced that Ainna V. Kaundu has been appointed as Acting CEO at the Business and Intellectual Property Authority (BIPA) in Namibia until a substantive CEO is appointed. She has previously served as the Executive of Intellectual Property Services within BIPA.

#### Nigeria: Minister to launch IP policy for creative economy<sup>7,8</sup>

On October 14, 2024, Nigeria's Minister of Art, Culture, and Creative Economy, Hannatu Musawa, announced the launch of the revised National Intellectual Property (IP) Policy for the creative economy. The policy aims to strengthen IP protection, boost investment, and empower Nigeria's creative sectors. Doris Nkiruka Uzoka-Anite, Minister of Industry, Trade, and Investment, assured that the government is committed to updating outdated IP laws and protecting creators' rights. Both ministers spoke at a stakeholder forum in Abuja, marking the final steps before the policy is presented to the Federal Executive Council for approval.

#### OAPI: Set to go digital<sup>9</sup>

OAPI is going digital to enhance its services, providing faster IP protection and a more efficient system for all users. This digital transformation will increase accessibility, speed up processes and ensure transparency. These improvements aim to support innovators and businesses across the continent, making IP services more streamlined and user-friendly.

## OAPI Higher Appeals Commission: Final Session 2024<sup>10,11</sup>

The Higher Commission of Appeal (CSR) of the African Intellectual Property Organization (OAPI) began its final session of 2024 on October 21 at OAPI's headquarters in Yaoundé, Cameroon. The two-week session reviewed 11 cases. In line with OAPI's modernization efforts, the session adopted a hybrid format, combining in-person and remote participation. This approach enhanced broader participation from sector professionals and stakeholders, increased accessibility to intellectual property justice and optimization of legal procedures. The session saw strong participation, with around 15 professionals attending physically and others joining via videoconference from OAPI member states. Deliberations by the magistrates continued on October 29.

South Africa: Legal action taken to compel the President to sign the Copyright Amendment Bill into law<sup>12,13,</sup> 14,15

SECTION27, representing Blind SA, has filed an urgent application with South Africa's Constitutional Court against President Cyril Ramaphosa for failing to sign the Copyright Amendment Bill. The bill, passed by Parliament in February 2023, addresses the rights of blind and visually impaired people to access reading materials. The Constitutional Court had ruled in 2022 that the Copyright Act was unconstitutional, as it restricted the conversion of books into accessible formats without copyright holder consent. Despite a September 21, 2024 deadline for Parliament to amend the law, the President has not signed the bill. Blind SA is seeking an order to compel Ramaphosa to sign the bill within 10 days or reinstate the previous court-ordered exception. The Constitutional Court will hear two related applications in November regarding the rights of blind people to convert copyright works into accessible formats.
