Kenya: Court of Appeal Upholds Anti-Counterfeit Authority's Enforcement Powers¹

The Court of Appeal has upheld the Anti-Counterfeit Authority's (ACA) powers to search business premises, seize suspected counterfeit goods and arrest suspects, ruling that such enforcement actions do not automatically violate constitutional rights. The Court held that officers acting on reasonable suspicion and in compliance with the Constitution and the Anti-Counterfeit Act are lawfully exercising their statutory mandate. The case arose after the ACA raided commercial premises, seized goods suspected to be counterfeit and arrested a business proprietor before charges were filed. Although the High Court awarded the trader KSh500,000 (~USD3,865; JPY610,000) in damages for alleged constitutional violations, the Court of Appeal overturned that decision, finding that the lawful exercise of statutory powers does not, by itself, amount to a constitutional infringement.

The Court further held that businesses challenging ACA enforcement actions must demonstrate that officers acted unlawfully, exceeded their statutory authority or failed to follow due process. The ruling strengthens the ACA's enforcement mandate and provides greater legal certainty for inspections and enforcement operations against counterfeit goods. At the same time, the Court reaffirmed that constitutional safeguards remain in place, allowing businesses and individuals to challenge enforcement actions where officers act outside the law or fail to comply with due process.

Kenya: Kenya Copyright Board Suspends Kenya Association of Music Producers Over Alleged Royalty Misappropriation²

The Kenya Copyright Board (KECOBO) has suspended the operating license of the Kenya Association of Music Producers (KAMP) for 90 days after alleging the misappropriation of more than KSh5.5 million (~USD42,500; JPY6,725,000) in royalty funds intended for rights holders. Following a regulatory review, KECOBO found that KAMP diverted royalty funds to activities unrelated to royalty distribution, failed to meet the mandatory royalty distribution threshold, issued licences below gazetted tariffs and lacked a transparent system for distributing royalties. The Board concluded that these actions breached the Copyright Act, licensing conditions and regulatory directives.

During the suspension, KAMP has been directed to stop issuing licences, collecting royalties and negotiating tariffs, and to refund the allegedly misapplied funds. KECOBO stated that KAMP's licence will only be reconsidered once it has addressed the identified governance, financial and compliance failures. Meanwhile, the Performing and Audio Visual Rights Society of Kenya (PAVRISK) will temporarily collect and hold royalties on KAMP's behalf.

Kenya: Ministry of Investments, Trade and Industry Through the State Department for Industry Launches Nationwide Public Consultations on the Draft National Intellectual Property Policy and Strategy 2026^{3,4}

The Ministry of Investments, Trade and Industry, through the State Department for Industry, launched a nationwide public participation exercise on the Draft National Intellectual Property Policy and Strategy (NIPPS), which was published in June 2026. The proposed policy seeks to establish a comprehensive framework for leveraging intellectual property to promote innovation, creativity, competitiveness and economic growth. The Ministry held regional stakeholder forums across the country from 27 to 31 July 2026. Members of the public, innovators, researchers, industry players, rights holders and other stakeholders were invited to review the draft policy and submit their comments and feedback.

Madagascar: Strengthens International Intellectual Property Cooperation Through European Patent Office Partnership and Launch of IPTIA (Institute for Intellectual Property and Technology in Madagascar)⁵

Madagascar has strengthened its intellectual property framework through two major international initiatives led by the Malagasy Industrial Property Office (OMAPI). The country signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the European Patent Office to enhance technical cooperation and align its patent systems with international best practices. The MoU was concluded during the EPO delegation's meetings held from 7 to 9 July 2026, although the precise date of signature has not been publicly confirmed.

Madagascar also signed a Letter of Intent with the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) to establish the Institute for Intellectual Property and Technology in Madagascar (IPTIA), which will support IP education, research and innovation. The initiatives are aimed at promoting a knowledge-based economy, enhancing competitiveness and attracting investment.

South Africa: Constitutional Court Declares Key Provisions of the Copyright Amendment Bill Unconstitutional, Returning Bills to Parliament⁶

The Constitutional Court has declared key provisions of the Copyright Amendment Bill unconstitutional, preventing both the Copyright Amendment Bill and the Performers' Protection Amendment Bill from being enacted in their current form. In *Ex parte President of the Republic of South Africa: In re Constitutionality of the Copyright Amendment Bill and the Performers' Protection Amendment Bill* [2026] ZACC 26, the Court found that the proposed educational and academic copyright exceptions in sections 12D(1)–(5) were inconsistent with the Constitution.

The Court reaffirmed that copyright is a form of property protected under section 25(1) of the Constitution, holding that the proposed exceptions were overly broad and lacked adequate safeguards, potentially resulting in an arbitrary deprivation of property rights. However, the Court upheld the constitutionality of the proposed fair use provision and several related exceptions. The judgment means the existing Copyright Act and Performers' Protection Act remain in force while Parliament revises the Bills. The decision provides important guidance for future copyright reform and has significant implications for copyright owners, creators, publishers, educational institutions and other stakeholders as the legislative process continues.
