

RISE-A (Revolutionary Innovation by Semiconductor Ecosystem for All industries)

Establishment registration completed on May 7, press release on July 16, base completion and full-scale activities starting in October.

"Create ecosystem to promote industry innovation by semiconductor which leads to strengthening Japan's next generation competitiveness."

- As an industrial developer, Mitsui Fudosan introduces its third industry support community, following LINK-J (Life Sciences) and cross U (Space).
- Create ecosystem that includes not only semiconductor industry in the narrow sense (supply side such as design/manufacturing), but also wide sense of semiconductor industry (supporter side such as users that utilize semiconductor)



RISE-A is a General Incorporated Association aiming to build an ecosystem for industrial innovation utilizing semiconductors through the provision of spaces and opportunities.

Providing various functions to semiconductor suppliers, semiconductor users, and supporters to reduce the cost of information dissemination and collection, as well as networking, while enhancing efficiency.





- Access: 1-minute walk from Mitsukoshimae Station (Tokyo Metro) / 12-minute walk from Tokyo Station










