## South FL: A History of Driving Tech Innovation



- 1973 First mobile telephone call made from Plantation, FL
- 1981 First PC designed by IBM in Boca Raton, FL
- 1984 Launch of first cell phone (Motorola's DynaTAC)
- 1996 Yupi.com launches (acquired by Microsoft & Telmex)
- 1999 Terra launches (acquired by Telefonica)
- 2000 Patagon (acquired by Banco Santander)
- 2001 NAP of the Americas is built in Downtown Miami, FL
- 2011 Terremark sells to Verizon (\$2B enterprise value)
- 2014 First annual eMerge Americas conference launches
- 2016 Miami becomes #1 for startup activity in the U.S.
- 2017 Cyxtera Technologies launches
- 2019 Rise of the Rest (Steve Case) comes to Florida
- 2020 AppGate launches






