

DEMOGRAPHIC OVERVIEW

According to Statistics Canada, they were 832,328 residents in the area in 2020, a 0.9% increase compared to 2019. Québec City's performance in 2020 was supported by natural increase, and especially migratory increase, which, despite declines from the previous year, were both positive. The effects of the pandemic, such as the increase in the number of deaths and the slowdown in migratory flows explain the performance of these two components of population growth.

The economy in the Québec City region has been growing for almost 25 years, with one of the best growth rates in Canada.



RESIDENTIAL AND NON-RESIDENTIAL INVESTMENTS

The region's 2020 non-residential investment report shows an annual decline of 3.6%. All in all, a relatively favourable scenario considering the pandemic context. The residential sector had a diametrically opposed year. The sector made headlines and several of its indicators ended the year at an all-time high.






