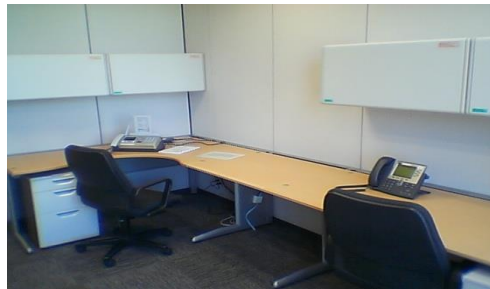

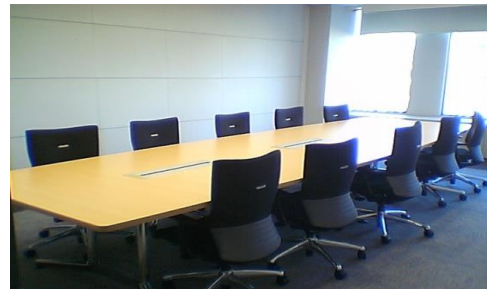
How to access JETRO services
