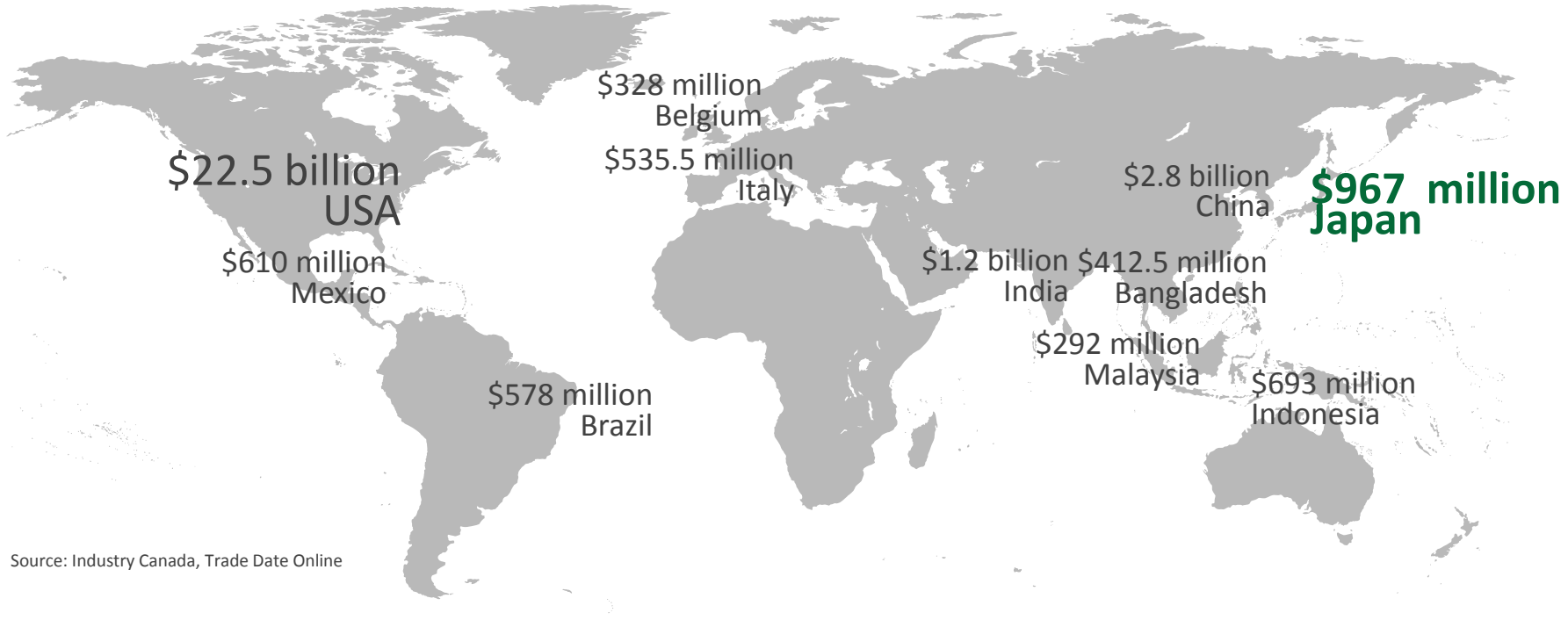

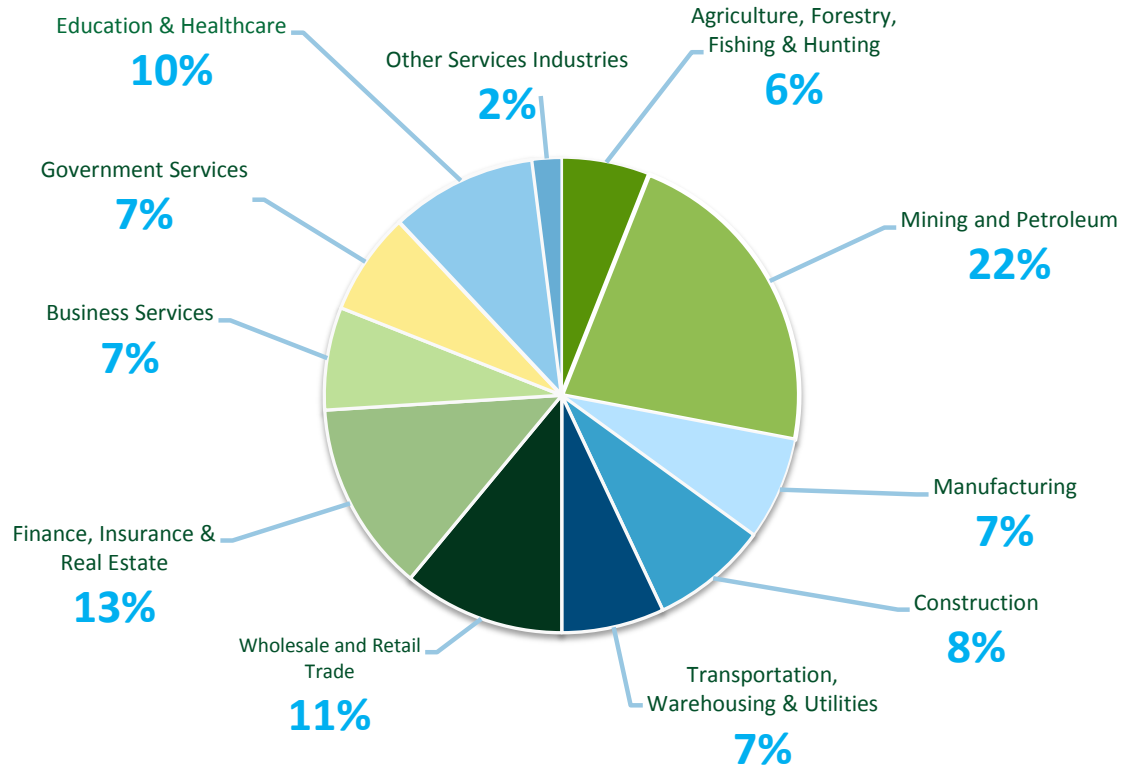
Central Location

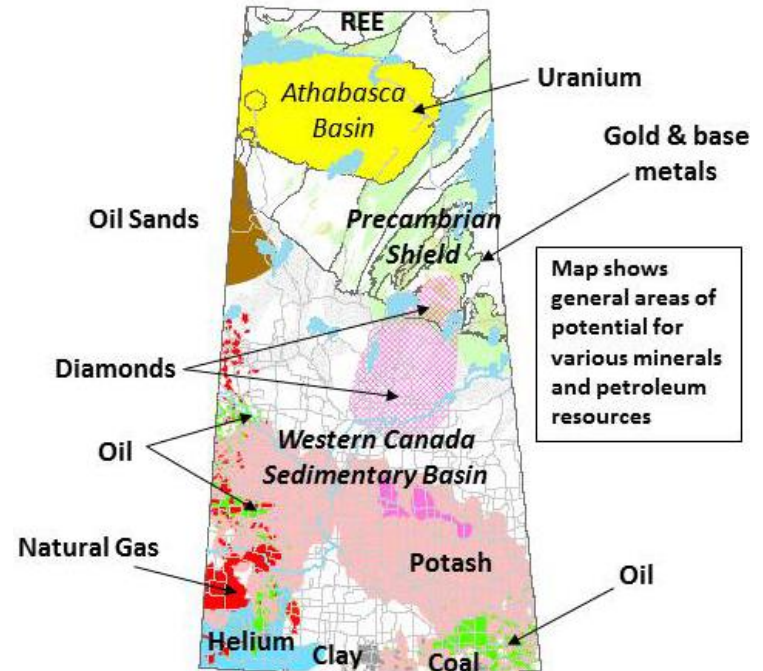

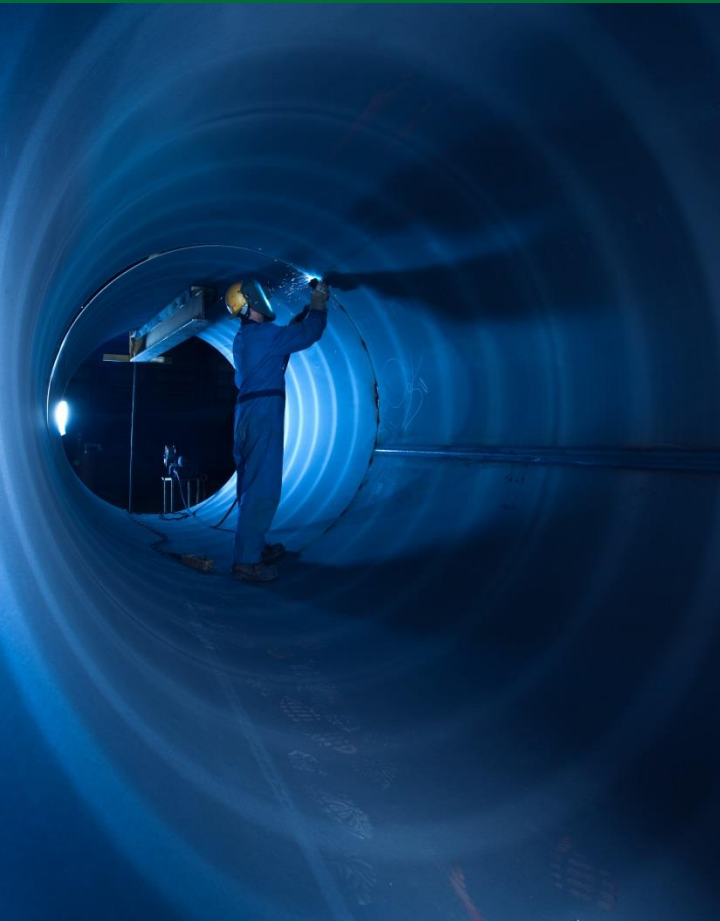

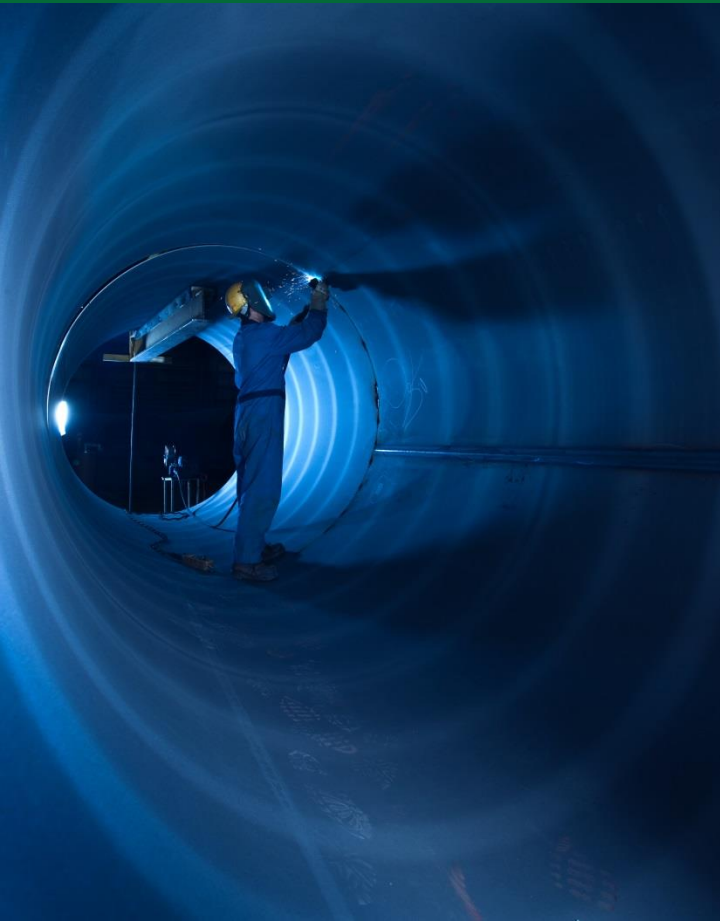
