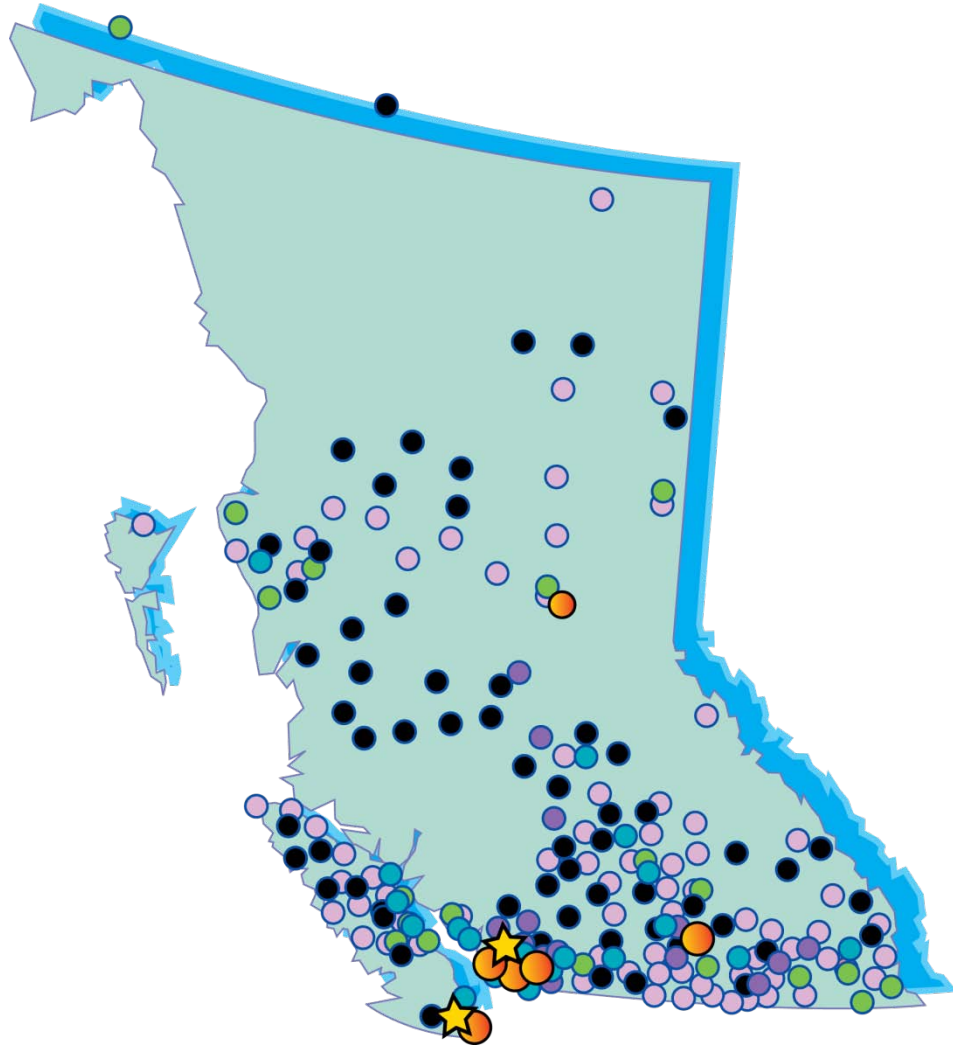

B.C. SIGNS AGREEMENT WITH JAPANESE COMPANY TO BEAT CANCER

OSAKA, JPN – The BC Cancer Agency and the Vancouver Prostate Centre announced a formal agreement with Japan-based Takeda Pharmaceutical Co. Ltd. for new drug treatments to fight breast, ovarian and prostate cancers.

The agreement is expected to bring almost \$1 million in new cancer research funding to British Columbia.

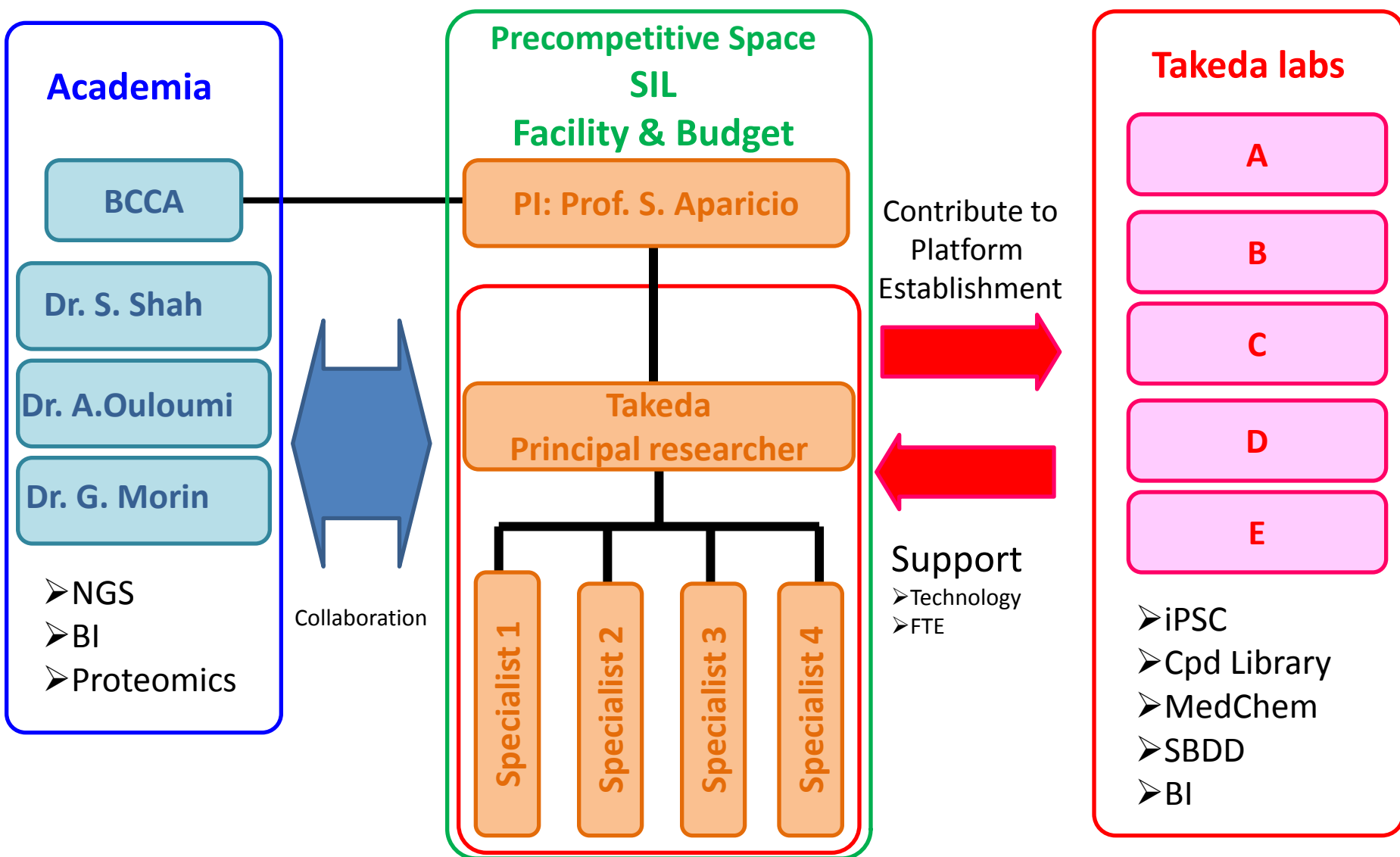


- Inviting external scientists to conduct and/or direct research at the Shonan Research Center

 - Researchers from all over the world including Japan working side by side with Takeda Researchers

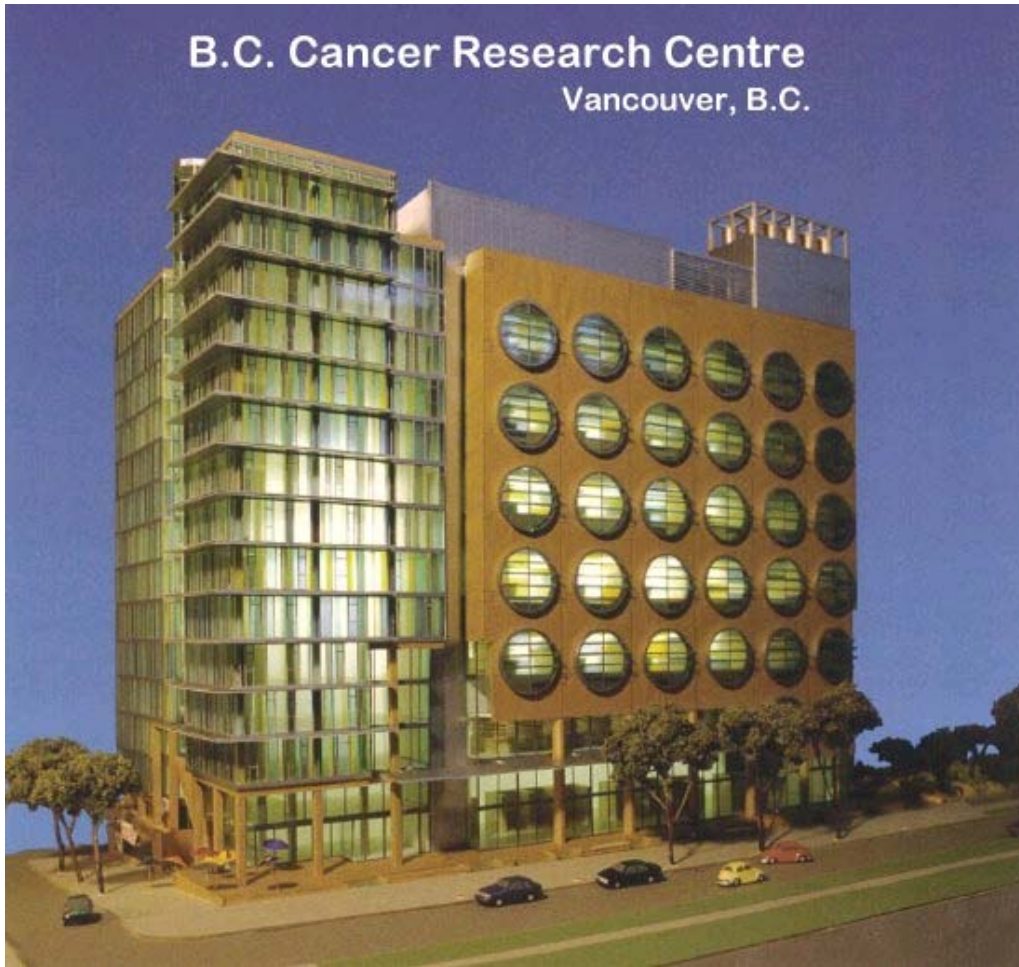
SIL concept

- To generate a continuous flow of innovative research such as novel target and cutting edge technology
- To accomplish above purpose by inviting top-tier researchers (dispatch) from external organization, such as academia to pursue collaborative research with Takeda researchers
- To foster 'supportive environment for innovation' and 'open-minded culture' through open discussion among invited external and Takeda researchers with collaborations in Shonan Research Center, which is also lead to people development
- Need endorsement from at least one DDU/Labs/GM and commitment to lead project by the DDU/Labs/GM
- SIL is not a rental laboratories, just sharing lab space
