Business Going Global


82.8%

of Japanese companies surveyed wish to expand operation abroad.






Changing Business Environment




Ratio of Japanese companies with foreign employee





Surging no. of Foreign Workers













Surging no. of Foreign Students










Occupational Stability Matters

✓ Attracting and retaining talents is a priority in Japanese companies, according to the IMD World Talent Ranking.




Large vs Small

Visas & Status of Residence



"Status of Residence" defines the activities you are allowed to do during your stay in Japan. There are about 30 types, and you can only legally engage in the activities specified by your "status of Residence".

Engineer/Specialist in Humanities/International Services

To engage in the occupational activities with the "Gi - Jin - Koku" status, your educational background or vocational experience must relate to your job description.

Example of Activity

mechanical engineer, software engineer, researcher, marketing specialist, sales executive, data analyst, interpreter, designer, language instructor

Period of Stay

5 year, 3 year, 1 year, or 3 months

- Can call spouse and child
- Can apply permanent residency after 10 consecutive years



Highly Skilled Professional

Principally, if you has stayed in Japan for more than **10 years** consecutively and in which has had work permit for more than **5 years**, you can apply for permanent residence




If you meet a certain criteria (education, work experience, salary, etc.), you can apply for the points-based status of residence called "Highly Skilled Professionals", in which you can apply permanent residence after having worked in **1-3 years**.

Japanese Green Card

Required period of residence for application for permanent residence



Example of point calculation



Software Engineer (29 years old)

29 years old or younger	15 points
Annual salary JPY 5 million more ≒\$ 50,000	15 points
Master's degree	20 points
Job experience of 3 years	5 points
JLPT N2 holder Bonus	10 points
Graduated from a top-tier university Bonus	10 points
TOTAL	75 points


