





JETRO Survey on Japanese Companies

JETRO Survey on Business Conditions of Japanese Companies in Europe (as of Sep.2022)

- 46.2% of Japanese companies responding to the survey indicated that they would expand their business in Europe within the next one to two years.
- 48.8% indicated that they would maintain the same level of business activity in Europe.
- 37.9% of Japanese companies in Europe(all sectors) forecast "Increase" of operating profit in 2023, compared to 2022.






Surging number of Foreigners

Number of foreign workers in Japan





Visas & Status of Residence




"Status of Residence" defines the activities you are allowed to do during your stay in Japan. There are about 30 types, and you can only legally engage in the activities specified by your "status of Residence".

To engage in employment, your educational background or vocational experience must relate to your job description.

Your Appropriate Status of Residence

1. Gi – Jin – Koku (技術·人文知識·国際業務)



2. Point-based preferential immigration treatment for highly skilled foreign professionals (高度人材ポイント制による優遇制度)

The Immigration Services Agency introduced this system in order to increase the number of highly skilled foreign professionals who are accepted for work in Japan.
