Niigata

Industry clusters exist for metallic product fabrication, electronics and mechanical manufacturing, general machinery manufacturing and other areas.

Saijyo city

Aichi

Aichi has one of the largest aerospace industry concentrations in Japan.

Kiyosu city

International strategic zone, set up for aerospace industry originally in Aichi and Gifu prefecture, has been spreading its area to Mie, Nagano and Shizuoka prefecture.

Kitanagoya city

It is suitable for the establishment of enterprises such as the aerospace industry, as Komaki-Minami factory of Mitsubishi Heavy Industry, the Mitsubishi Regional Jet's (MRJ) final assembly factory, and the aviation experiment base of JAXA locate in neighboring areas.

Nagoya city

Nagoya city is Japan's largest manufacturing center with clusters of industries in automobiles and aircrafts. Other various companies that support these industries are also accumulated in this city.
