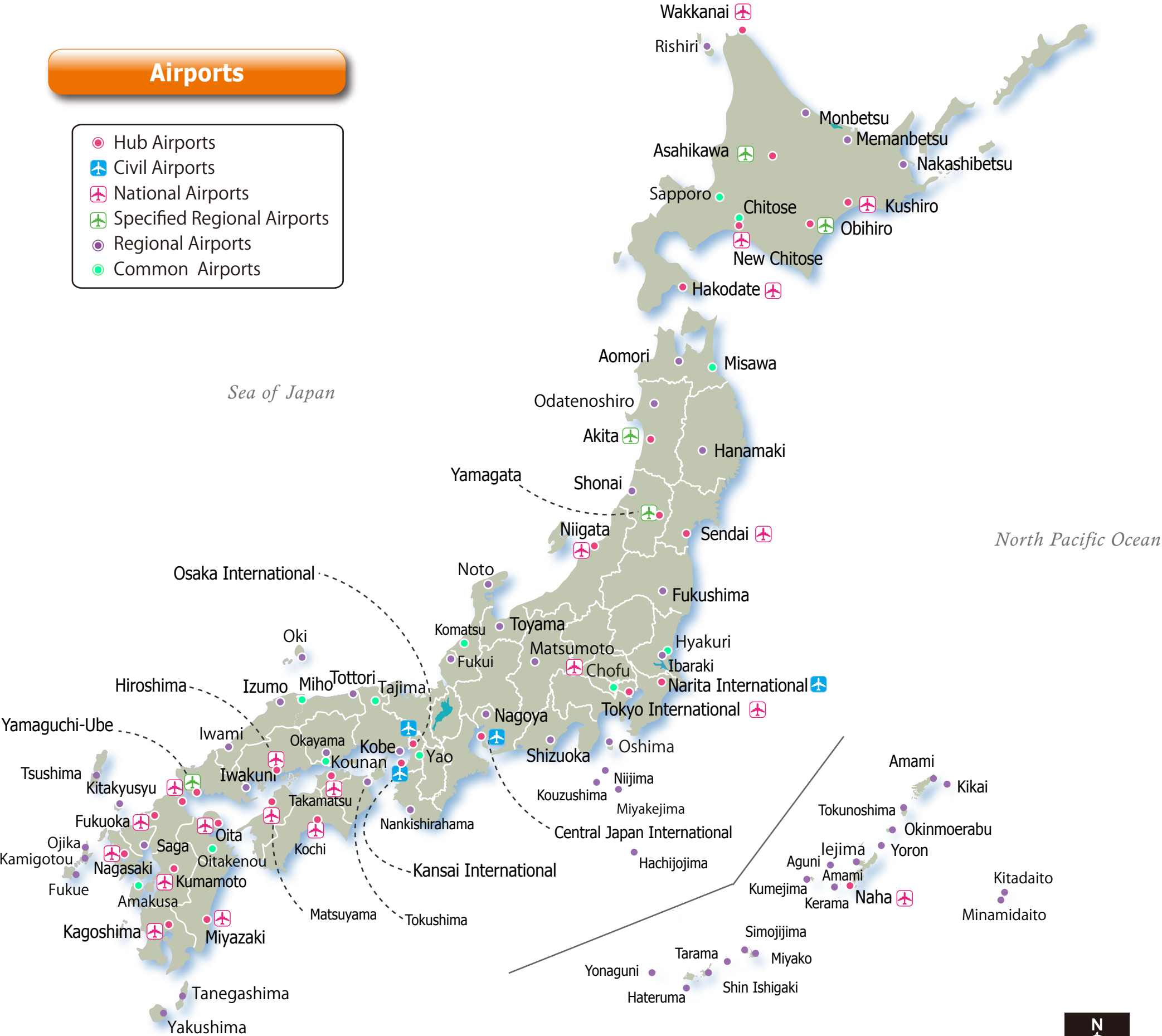

*Hub airports: Base of international and domestic air transportation networks

Japan is an island nation of some 6,852 islands with total land area of approximately 377,900 km², and has 97 airports. A safe and punctual public transportation system including trains and buses is convenient to move around in Japan.

< Move to major cities >

- Tokyo: 59 min. from Narita International Airport to 'Tokyo station' by the Narita Express Train
- Yokohama: about 35 min. from Tokyo International Airport to 'Yokohama station' by Airport Limousine Bus
- Nagoya: Shortest 28 min. from Central Japan International Airport to 'Nagoya station' by Nagoya Railroad express train "μSky"
- Osaka: about 50 min. from Kansai International Airport to 'Shin-Osaka station' by JR express train
- Kobe: about 60 min. from Kansai International Airport to 'JR Nishinomiya station' by Airport Limousine Bus
- Fukuoka: 11 min. from Fukuoka Airport to 'Tenjin station' by the Kuko (Airport) line
