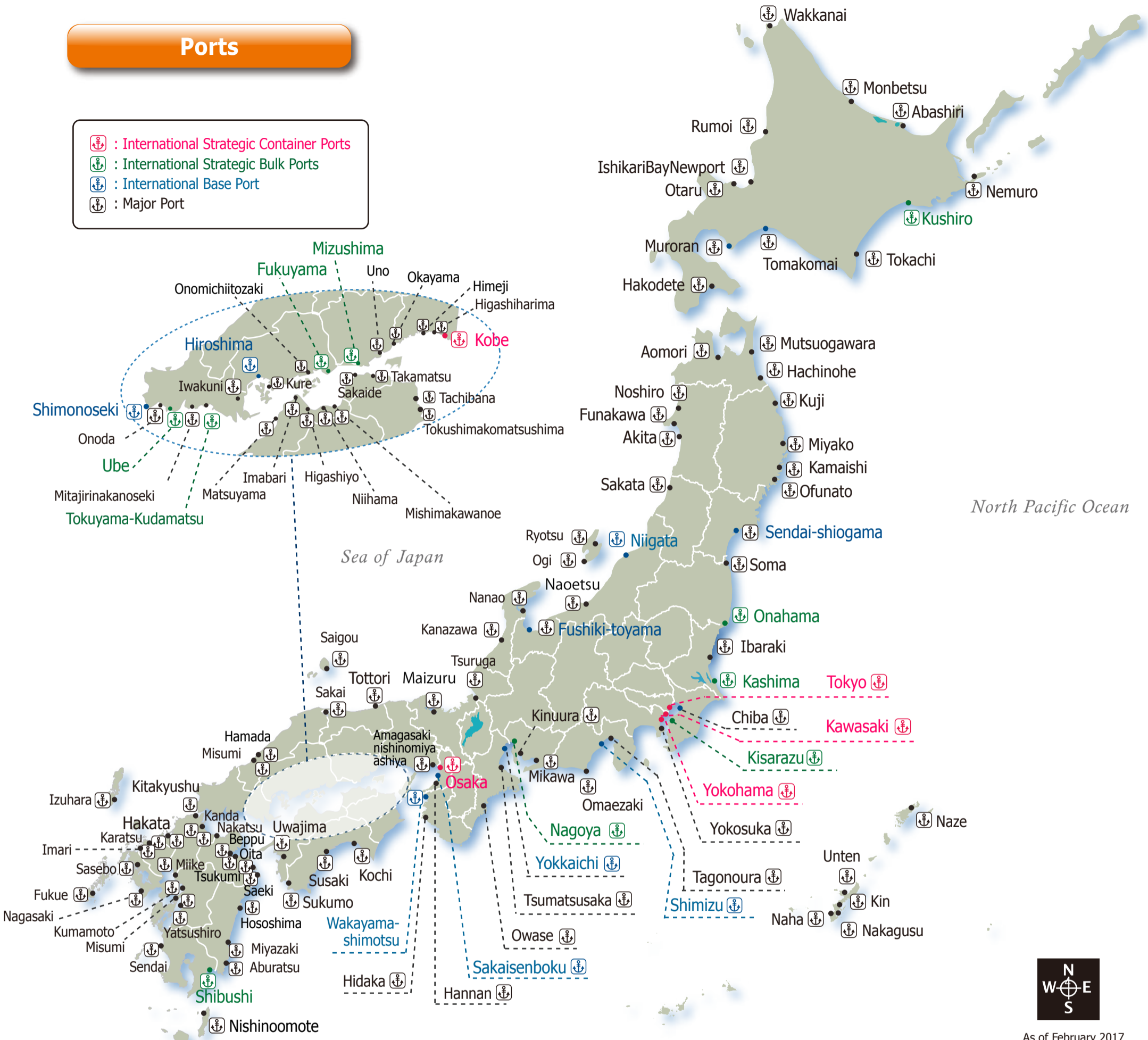

- Grain: Kashima (Kagoshima Pref.), Shibushi (Kagoshima Pref.), Nagoya (Aichi Pref.), Mizushima (Okayama Pref.), Kushiro (Hokkaido Pref.)
- Iron ore: Kisarazu (Chiba Pref.), Mizushima (Okayama Pref.)/Fukuyama (Hiroshima Pref.)
- Coal: Tokuyama-Kudamatsu/Ube (both Yamaguchi Pref.), Onahama (Fukushima Pref.)
