



Outline of Collaboration

Rekosistem operates a digital platform that collects various kinds of waste (such as plastics, cardboard, paper, glasses, E-waste, etc.) from corporate enterprises and individuals by using a digital platform, which gives users points that can be used for electronic payments in accordance with the amount of waste collected.

In Indonesia, where the establishment of an appropriate waste collection system and the spread of recycling have become issues as the population increases, this business alliance will help to develop waste collection sources, increase the amount of waste collected, and develop a recycling business including commercialization and marketing of collected waste by utilizing the Marubeni Group's network.

Outline of Collaboration

Jointly proposed the above project with Sunway University, Sarawak Forestry Corporation, and Aerosense Inc. for the "International collaborative Research Program 2021" which is promoted by research institutes of member countries of the Asia-Pacific Telecommunity and Japanese companies. With the aim of collecting and visualizing scientific data that will contribute to policymaking for mangrove conservation, the analysis accuracy of AI technology such as image recognition was improved and verification of usefulness was conducted through joint data analysis with Sunway University and data evaluation by Sarawak Forestry Corporation.

Outline of Collaboration

Cresco (Cresco Vietnam), an IT system construction and maintenance provider for local Vietnamese restaurants and retailers, jointly developed the "Capichi Connect function" with other two companies to connect and integrate Hungry Bear Internet's POS system "LOOP SMART POS" and Capichi's dedicated delivery application "Capichi Food Delivery" which has been used at about 1,000 stores including Japanese restaurants. Pilot project in Kenya to provide financing services for electric bicycle riders

Outline of Collaboration

HAKKI purchased 200 electric bicycles from ARC Ride and sold them in installments to low-credit borrowers (mainly food delivery workers) who cannot obtain bank loans, through a financing service using the company's proprietary credit scoring system, thereby expanding its business domain by adding new financial services for electric bicycles to conventional financing services for used four-wheeled vehicles. ARC Ride, on the other hand, will improve electric bicycles, increase the durability of batteries, and develop more efficient charging stations based on the feedback from users provided by HAKKI.

Through this collaboration, the two companies plan to expand their financing services for electric bicycles to African countries other than Kenya.

Outline of Collaboration

DENSO developed small mobile refrigerators with Yamato Transport and installed them in electric motorcycles for delivery companies, which had been manufactured by Selex, an electric motorcycle manufacturer and rechargeable battery subscription business operator. Then, DENSO conducted a six-month demonstration test starting in February 2023, to measure demand and collect data related to low-temperature transportation.

Selex is building an electric motorcycle delivery network with a major EC site company. DENSO aims to contribute to solving logistics

issues in Vietnam by participating in the establishment of a cold chain through collaboration with Selex.
