Topic: "Long-Term Economic Effects of Japanese Roots in German Football"

The slogan "sport unites" is not only valid for culture but also for economy. The Bundesliga currently features 12 Japanese players – six of whom also play for the Japanese national team. This shows that Bundesliga plays an important role for the development and success of Japanese football and, at the same time, reflects the wide-ranging Japanese influence on the Bundesliga.

Our speaker will outline the long-term socio-political and economic impacts of such significant Japanese roots in German football. How could Japanese businesses benefit from the importance of Japanese players in the Bundesliga and from the league's status as one of the best in the world and how – vice versa – can German companies utilize this as a competitive advantage over other international companies in the Japanese market? Furthermore, what are resulting effects for the large Japanese community living in Germany and how can the Japanese presence in German football support the cultivation of the partnership between our two countries?

Axel Hellmann studied law in Würzburg, Bristol and Berlin. After international mandates in England and the U.S. he worked as lawyer and partner at a corporate law firm in Frankfurt from 2005 to 2012. At the same time, he held the position of Vice President and Managing Director of the Executive Board of Eintracht Frankfurt e.V. from 2001 to 2012 and was a Supervisory Board Member of Eintracht Frankfurt Fußball AG from 2003 to 2012. Since June 1st 2012 he is a Member of the Executive Board of Eintracht Frankfurt Fußball AG in his function as CFO.
