

# Make Banda-Aceh more resilient and sustainable using smart solutions

Tsunami in 2004 (Dec. 26)

- 129,775 deaths, 38,786 missing and 504,518 tsunami-displaced in Aceh Province\*
- Huge economic losses and damage to infrastructure, agriculture etc. (total damages and losses amount to 97% of Aceh's GDP\*
