Others," and make entry in "Notification of a Applicable Employee" only in () of "5. Others" (in this case, a certificate of the insured person enrolled in health insurance will not be issued.)

This notification will be submitted in the "case of hiring an employee" and in the "case of re-employing a worker aged 60 or older continuously after retirement."

- When submitting the notification for an employee aged 70 or older, circle "1. Applicable to employees aged 70 and older" in the column for "Remarks [10]."
- In the following cases, submit the notification via the separate forms stated below.
 - When an employee, etc., reaches 70 years of age during his/her tenure -> "Notification of Reaching 70 Years of Age" (Notification of Loss of Qualifications) / "Notification of an Applicable Employee Aged 70 and Older"
 - When hiring an employee joining National Health Insurance Societies -> "Notification of the Acquisition of the Qualifications of an Insured Person" (for National Health Insurance)
