SUMMARY BRIEF

The Osaka Expo 2025provides a unique platform for Kenya to showcase its export products, Magical Kenya tourism and the vast opportunities for investment. Kenya therefore seeks to engage with the representatives of the Japanese public and private sector on the sidelines of the Osaka Expo to spur collaboration for increased economic ties. For this reason, the Kenya Export Promotion and Branding Agency (KEPROBA) will host the Kenya-Japan High Level Business Forum on June 23, 2025 at the Osaka International Convention Centre, Osaka.

The Forum is supported by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan, Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry of Japan and the Japan External Trade Organization and will bring together exporters, importers, investors, government organizations from Kenya and Japan. Participants in the Forum will benefit from the following key activities;

- i. Policy statements by senior government officials from Kenya and Japan
- ii. Presentations by leading government and private sector representatives from Kenya including KEPROBA, Kenya Investment Authority (KenInvest), Kenya Tourism Board Kenya National Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KNCCI), and the Japanese counterparts;
- iii. Panel discussions focusing Kenya's trade and investment with Japan
- iv. Business to Business engagements targeting key sectors with high potential;
- v. Presentations on the opportunities for investment, trade and tourism specific to various Counties in Kenya,
- vi. Site visits to be arranged on need basis

Through the forum, Kenya seeks to achieve the following:

- i. Boost understanding of Kenya's economic potential among decision makers and opinion shapers in Japan
- ii. Enhanced business networks between Kenya and Japan
- iii. Increased knowledge of investment opportunities in Kenya including within the counties and evaluation of the investment climate for uptake by Japanese investors.
