Backed by government schemes to encourage innovation, Japan's biotech firms have moved out of stagnation and are now adding to the industry's progress. One such scheme, the "Super Special Consortia," allows for flexibility in R&D projects in such priority fields as regenerative medicine and iPS cell research. This session will discuss these and other topics."
