2 PROGRAM STRUCTURE | Program Overview

1 Tokyo Bootcamp



Location : Tokyo (JETRO HQ)
Duration : 3 Days

Aimed to prepare participants for the program by conducting workshops/lectures/1on1 sessions which will introduce the DeepTech scenes and highlight the differences between Japan and the U.S..

2 Berkeley On-Site Program*



Location : Berkeley or online
Duration : 6 Weeks

The first 6 weeks will be held on-site/online hybrid style with Workshops, 1-on-1 Mentoring, Mentor Meet & Greet, Intern Fair, and more. Networking events are in-person only, so on-site participation in Berkeley is strongly encouraged.

3 Online Program*



Location : Online
Duration : 6 Weeks

Drive forward participants' overseas expansion through providing business meeting opportunities with overseas companies in addition to workshops/mentoring. Pitch training will be provided to prepare startups for the DemoDay. (for selected startups only)

Tokyo Bootcamp

A 3-day Bootcamp held at JETRO Tokyo HQ. Workshops and 1on1 mentoring will be provided for the participants to grasp knowledge on founders' basics and strategies for entering the U.S. market.

 - Networking and discussions with mentors/entrepreneurs/investors/etc.
- **Legal Office Hour**
 - Legal advice on creating a startup/expanding business in the US
- **Intern Fair**
 - Coordinating online interviews with possible interns. Interns can be hired through this process.

Through workshops and mentoring, participants will further promote their US business expansion. Selected participants will pitch at the Demo day, which will be held at the end of the program.

 - DemoDay pitch training (story structuring, content, pitch delivery; selected startups only)
- **Legal Office Hour**
 - Legal advising continued from the Berkeley On-Site program
- **DemoDay**
 - A DemoDay with the opportunity to pitch to over 200 investors/international companies etc. (for selected startups only)
 - Opportunity for fundraising, business expansion and business partnerships
- **Closing Ceremony**
 - Lectures on how to take advantage and staying connected with the SkyDeck community

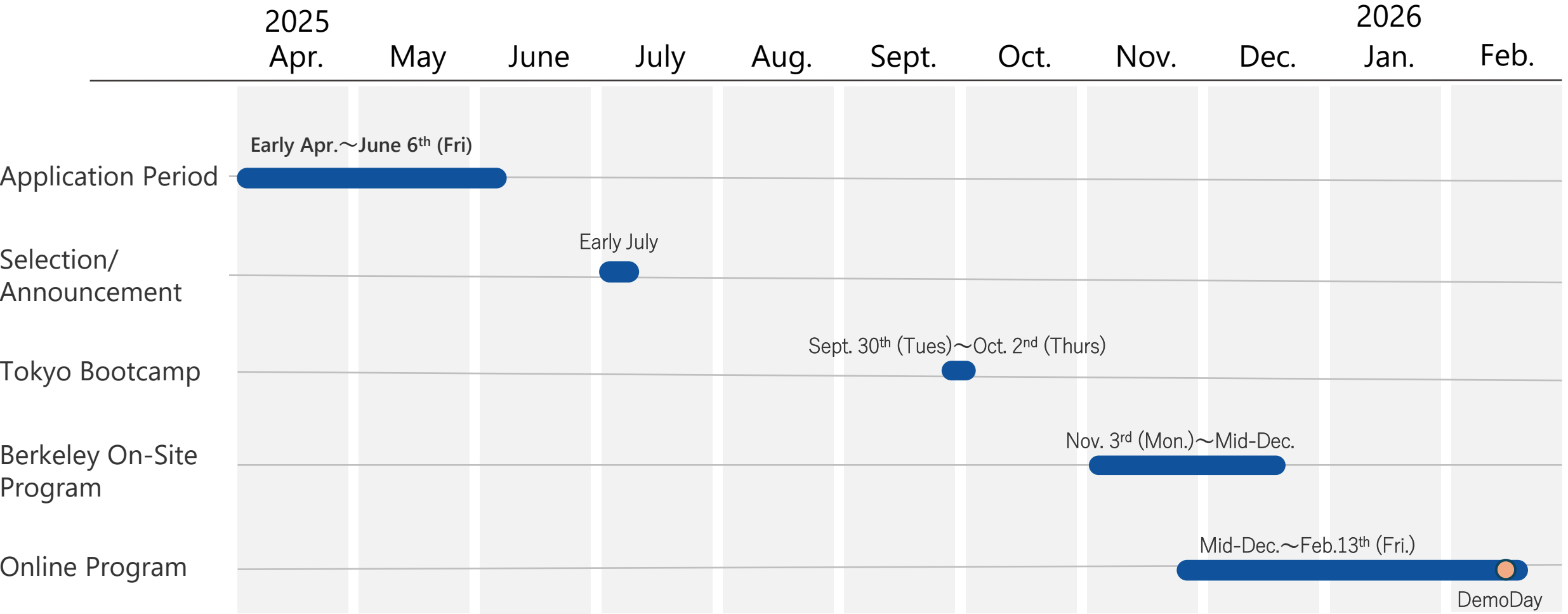

Applications reviewed by Berkeley SkyDeck and JETRO based on submitted materials. Finalists may be invited for interviews. No status inquiries accepted.

1. Team expertise, network, and language skills.
2. Product/service growth potential and market fit.
3. Alignment between course content and business goals.
4. Bonus points for Ecosystem Hub City-based startups.
