Notification of Department of Industrial Works

Re: Prescribing fine for violation of industrial effluent discharge that are not in compliance with the Ministerial Notification issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E.2535 (1992)

To protect the environment from pollution generated from factory operation, a factory entrepreneur shall realize the significance of standard concerning any pollution that may have an impact on the environment which results in nuisance and safety of the public living nearby a factory and shall be strictly in compliance with the law.

Department of Industrial Works hereby implements a policy in setting up fine rate for a factory that discharges its industrial effluent that are not coherent with industrial effluent standard under the Ministerial Notification. The fine rate shall be prescribed as shown in the list annexed hereto.

List of prescribed fine rate for wastewater effluent discharging from a factory.

Description	Fine rate (Baht)
1. Case of effluent with characteristics exceeding the effluent	
standard	
1.1 exceeding less than 2 times of the prescribed standard	Not exceeding 10,000
1.2 exceeding 2 times but less than 4 times of the prescribed	10,000 - 50,000
standard	
1.3 exceeding 4 times but less than 7 times of the prescribed	25,000 – 100,000
standard	
1.4 exceeding 7 times but less than 10 times of the	50,000 - 150,000
prescribed standard	
1.5 exceeding more than 10 times of the prescribed standard	75,000 – 200,000
2. Case of not operate wastewater treatment system, or	10,000 - 200,000
illegally discharging wastewater without treatment	
3. In case it results in damage to the public, the environment,	10,000 - 200,000
or receiving water	

Remark: 1. for first case, if there is more than one parameter that exceeds the standard, only the parameter with the highest violation shall be subjected to fine.

- 2. for violation more than one item, the item with the highest fine shall be considered.
- 3. if a violator is legal entity, both legal entity and every authorized person for such legal entity shall be subjected to fine at the same rate.
