Notification of Department of Industrial Works
Re: Prescribing type of industrial furnace
allowable for use of processed used-oil or synthetic fuel
B.E. 2547 (2004)

With reference to Article 1 paragraph four of the Ministerial Notification regarding Specification of processed used oil and synthetic fuel as alternative fuel for furnace oil in an industrial furnace B.E. 2547 (2004) stating that ““Industrial furnace” shall mean industrial furnace employed in production process of steel rolling factory, metallurgy facility, and other factory as prescribed by Department of Industrial Works, but not include cement kiln or lime kiln that have co-incineration of waste or hazardous waste incinerator with the purpose of burning for destruction under the factory type 101 (Central Waste treatment) of the attached list to the Ministerial Regulation (B.E. 2535(1992)) issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992)”. To clarify and ease the compliance with the Ministerial Notification, Department of Industrial Works hereby announces type of industrial furnace as follows:

Industrial furnace shall be,

1. An industrial furnace employed in a production process of factory type 59 (Iron and Steel Basic Industries) of the list annexed to the Ministerial Regulation (B.E.2535 (1992)) issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992).

2. An industrial furnace employed in a production process of factory type 60 (Non-ferrous Metal Basic Industries) of the list annexed to the Ministerial Regulation (B.E.2535 (1992)) issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992).

3. An industrial furnace employed in a production process of factory type 88 (factory manufacturing, supplying or distributing electric energy) of the list annexed to the Ministerial Regulation (B.E.2535 (1992)) issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992).

4. Heating devices employed in the production process of factory type 58(1) (factory manufacturing of concrete products, mixed concrete products, gypsum products or plaster products) of the list annexed to the Ministerial Regulation (B.E.2535 (1992)) issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992).

5. Boilers employed in general production process.

This shall, thus, enter into force on the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
