The Energy Conservation Promotion Fund Committee has a resolution in the meeting No. 1/2548 (No. 1) on 26 January 2005 to end the subsidy from Energy Conservation Promotion Fund (ENCON Fund) for Designated Factory and Designated Building as following details:

- 1. End of the ENCON Fund subsidy for designated factory and designated building to prepare the preliminary energy consumption audit and analysis report, energy conservation target and plan, and implementation of energy conservation measure as specified in the ENCON Fund Committee Regulation No. 1 B.E. 2537, and No. 2 B.E. 2539. It is effective from 26 January 2005.
- 2. Designated factory and designated building that submits the preliminary energy consumption audit and analysis report to DEDE before 26 January 2005 can apply for the subsidy as specified in the ENCON Fund Committee Regulation. The approved subsidy for the FY2005 will come from the budget of energy efficiency increasing plan, promotion and demonstration work.
- 3. End of the subsidy for the implementation of energy conservation measure specified in the energy conservation target and plan to designated factory and designated building that has not received an approval of subsidy from DEDE.
