Ministerial Regulation B.E. 2535 (1992) Issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E.2535 (1992)

By the virtue of section 5, section 6 and section 7 of the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992), the Minister of Industry hereby issues the Ministerial Regulation as follows:

Clause 1 A factory of each type and group as prescribed in the list annexed to this Ministerial Regulation shall be a factory under the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992).

Clause 2 The factory under clause 1 shall be classified into group 1 factory, group 2 factory and group 3 factory as prescribed in the list annexed to this Ministerial Regulation.

Note: The reason for the enactment of this ministerial regulation is prescribed in the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992) that the Minister shall have the power to issue the ministerial regulation prescribing the type and category of a factory that must be subject to this act, and that the factory shall be classified into three groups, i.e. the group 1 factory can be engaged in the factory business immediately as the factory operator wishes; the group 2 factory shall be subjected to notification requirement prior to engaging in the factory business, and the group 3 factory shall be subjected to permit application prior to engaging in the factory business; it is therefore necessary to issue this ministerial regulation.
