Ministerial Regulation No. 14 B.E. 2544 (2001) Issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E.2535 (1992)

By the virtue of section 6 and section 43 of the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992), which contains some provisions concerning the limitation of the people rights and liberties that is permissible by the provisions of section 29 together with section 35, section 48 and section 50 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand, the Minister of Industry hereby issues the Ministerial Regulation as follows:

Clause 1 To repeal Clause 2 of the Ministerial Regulation No. 8 (B.E. 2535 (1992)) issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992) and its amendment in the Ministerial Regulation No. 12 (B.E. 2540 (1997)) and apply the following statement instead.

"Clause 2 A factory business operator shall present a proof of notification document or a factory permit, as the case maybe, along with a payment of the annual fee. This provision shall not apply to the factory located in an industrial zone in accordance with section 30 of the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992) and the factory paying the annual fee through commercial banks as prescribed in Clause 3 paragraph two."

Clause 2 To append the following statement as paragraph two of Clause 3 of the Ministerial Regulation No. 8 (B.E. 2535 (1992)) issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992) and its amendment in the Ministerial Regulation No. 12 (B.E. 2540 (1997)) issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992).

"In case a factory located in Bangkok Metropolitan Area or in other provinces wishes to make the payment of the annual fee through commercial banks that have computerized system linked to the computer network of Department of Industrial Works, the factory shall submit the notice of the annual fee payment to such commercial bank. The notice form shall be as prescribed by Department of Industrial Works."
