Notification of Ministry of Industry
Re: Prescribing type of raw material to be used in a factory

By the virtue of section 32(1) and (2) of the Factory Act B.E. 2535(1992) which contains some provisions concerning the limitation of the people rights and liberties that is permissible by the provisions of section 29 together with section 35, section 48 and section 50 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand, the Minister of Industry, with the approval of the cabinet, hereby issues the Ministerial Notification as follows:

Article 1 The following shall be repealed.

(1) The Ministerial notification No. 2 (B.E. 2540 (1997)) issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535(1992) regarding prohibited use of CFCs in production of household refrigerators, dated 24th March B.E. 2540 (1997).

(2) The Ministerial notification No. 3 (B.E. 2540 (1997)) issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535(1992) regarding prohibition of establishment or expansion of factory producing spray containers that uses CFCs, dated 24th March B.E. 2540 (1997).

(3) The Ministerial notification regarding prescribing type of raw material to be used in factory manufacturing commercial refrigerator, dated 17th December B.E. 2547 (2004).

Article 2 It shall be prohibited for every type of factory in the list annexed to the Ministerial Notification (B.E. 2535 (1992)), issued pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992), to use either CFCs or 1,1,1-Trichloroethane, or both, in the production process.

Article 3 This Ministerial Notification shall be effective on the expiration of 60 days from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
