

## **Notification of Ministry of Industry**

### **Re: Exemption from compliance with Hazardous Substance Act B.E. 2535 regarding production, possession, export and registration of hazardous substances (used electrical and electronic equipment) under responsibility of Department of Industrial Works B.E. 2546 (2003)**

By the virtue of the third paragraph of Article 5, and Article 20(5), the second paragraph of Article 36, and Article 44(1) of the Hazardous Substance Act B.E. 2535, which contains some provisions concerning the limitation of the person's rights and freedoms that can be done by the provisions of Section 29 combined with Section 31 and Section 50 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand, the Minister of Industry, approved by the Hazardous Substance Committee, hereby issues the notification as follows:

Article 1 Producer, exporter or possessor of used electrical and electronic equipment including their parts and components as listed in the annex of the Notification of Ministry of Industry prescribed in pursuant to the second paragraph of Article 18 shall be exempted from applying for permission according to the first paragraph of Article 23 and from registration according to the second paragraph of Article 36.

Article 2 Importer of used electrical and electronic equipment as listed in the annex of the Notification of Ministry of Industry prescribed in pursuant to the second paragraph of Article 18 for the purpose of personal use in the amount of not more than 2 units per item shall be exempted from applying for permission according to the first paragraph of Article 23 and for registration according to the second paragraph of Article 36.

Article 3 Importer of used electrical and electronic equipment including their parts and components as listed in the annex of the Notification of Ministry of Industry prescribed in pursuant to the second paragraph of Article 18 shall be exempted from applying for registration according to the second paragraph of Article 36.

This shall, thus, enter into force on the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
