



During 2009 – 2015, he served as Board of Director, Bank of Thailand and former the Chairman of National Health Security Financing Sub-Committee, National Health Security Office. In 2013, he has served as Chairman of the Board, Thai Smile Airways. Later, he served as Chairman of the Executive Committee Thai Airways during 2009-2017 and as State Railway of Thailand as Executive Vice President during 2016-2017.

Dr. Kanit holds a Ph.D. in Economics the University of Toronto, after receiving his Bachelors and Masters in Economics from Department of Economics, Thammasat University, Thailand.
