Global Scale	All fields	20		A US accelerator established in 2006. Techstars has always placed at the top in global accelerator rankings, and has implemented 50 acceleration programs around the world, through which about 7,000 startups have been cultivated so far.
Enterprise Business (B2B)	B2B, B2B2C Saas	20		A US accelerator that specializes in supporting and investing in early-stage enterprise startups for B2B or B2B2C transactions. It earned the highest ranking for an accelerator in the enterprise category. Program participants have raised more than \$1.4 billion in total.
Bio/Healthcare	Biotechnology, digital health, healthcare, medical equipment	16		An innovation center established in Cambridge, Massachusetts, USA, in 1999. It has strong connections with the pharmaceutical, life science and healthcare industries in the Boston area.
Deep Tech	Deep technology	20		An accelerator from the University of California, Berkeley. It has strengths in supporting university-originated startups making use of the university's human resources and environment.
Global Preparation	All fields	50		An accelerator and venture capital firm from Silicon Valley, USA. It has over 40 business bases around the world, including three offices in Tokyo, Kyoto and Osaka, Japan. It has strengths in matching large companies and startups, has helped around 2,000 startups and invests in approximately 200 companies every year. It provides hands-on support in Japanese for seed to early-stage startups.
