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## PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

**Two major policy changes have taken place recently in the area of pharmaceuticals and medical devices:**

- 1. Pharmaceuticals, Medical Devices & Regenerative Safety Law**
- 2. Regional Medical Alliance Law**

These new laws will allow for expedited approval for regenerative medicine, relaxation of regulations for outsourcing medical device manufacturing and cell processing, and will simplify the process for establishing consolidated medical management for regional medical alliances.

This seminar is designed for researchers, developers, and manufacturers of medical devices, pharmaceuticals, biotechnology, cellular processing at all stages of evolution, from startups to well-established companies in the field.

The Japanese government recently established a pool of funding to assist foreign-affiliated companies seeking to enter the Japanese biotech market. Funds are available to U.S. companies at every step of the market-entry process, from seeding and incubation support to commercialization and factory setup.
