

## ✓ JH2F Annual Meeting x VerdeXchange

**VerdeXchange** is an annual international conference held in Los Angeles since 2007. It brings together global leaders across energy, environment, and infrastructure sectors to discuss market trends, innovation, and sustainability.

On the third day of the conference, designated as the “Hydrogen Super Track,” a full day of hydrogen-focused panels took place. In conjunction with this, the JH2F Annual Meeting and Reception were held at the Omni Hotel, the main venue of the event.

The reception welcomed participation from U.S. organizations with strong interest in Japanese hydrogen technologies, including the Electric Power Research Institute ([EPRI](#)) and Saoradh Enterprise Partners LLC ([SEP](#)).

A highlight of the event was the introduction of the Japan Hydrogen Technology Map, a compilation of the capabilities of JH2F-affiliated companies. The map served as a key reference point, facilitating concrete and lively discussions among attendees.
