Overview of Trade Secret Protection in Thailand

- Trade Secrets protection in Thailand began from B.E.2545 (2002)
- Amended by the Trade Secret Act (No.2) B.E. 2558 (2015)
- The second amendment covers
 - Reorganizing Trade Secret Board and related provisions
 - Lower penalty of officials unlawfully disclose trade secret acquired by virtue of his position.

Trade Secret Protection

Trade Secret : trade information that is

- 1. not yet publicly known or not yet accessible by persons who are normally connected wit the information
- 2. has commercial values of which derive from its secrecy
- 3. the controller of the trade secrets has taken appropriate measures to maintain the secrecy

Rights of trade secret owner

- disclose,
- deprive of,
- use,
- License someone else to disclose, deprive of, or use the trade secret

Owner and Controller

Trade secret owner

 The person who discovered, invented, compiled or created the TS information

Trade secret <u>controller</u>

 The owner of TS. Include possessor, controller, or caretaker of the TS

Infringement

- The infringement : the act of disclosure, deprivation or usage of trade secrets without the consent of the owner in a manner contrary to honest trade practices.
- Injunctions : clear evidence that an infringement has been committed or is imminent, interim injunction to stop the infringement can be granted by the court.
- Conciliation and Mediation : the controller of TS and the other party may agree to submit the dispute to the TS Board for conciliation and mediation.
- Limitation Period : 10 years from the date of infringement

Exceptions

- Disclosure or use of by a person obtained through a transaction without knowing that the other party obtained TS through infringement
- 2. Disclosure or use of by state agency which is responsible for their maintenance in the following circumstances :
 - a) Necessary for the protection of public health or safety; or
 - b) Necessary for the benefit of other public interest with no commercial purpose. (must be taken reasonable steps to protect TS from being used in unfair trading activity)
- 3. Independent discover
- 4. Reverse Engineering



- I. Actual damages + account of profits accrued from or in connection with the infringement by the infringer
- 2. Where actual damage cannot be measured. Court may order damages as deemed appropriate
- 3. Punitive damages can be awarded if clear evidence that infringement is conducted willfully or maliciously causing the trade secrets to cease the quality of secrecy. Damages shall not exceed 2 times the amount of damages under 1 or 2

Penalties

person Any

Whosoever discloses a TS of other person which causes the TS to cease, with malicious intent

-Imprison not exceeding I yr or fine not exceeding 200,000 baht

Whosoever, having Orug & Agri Officials* position to preserved TS according to Art. 15 (Drugs/Agri products) unlawfully discloses or use TS for his own or someone

-Imprison not exceeding 2 yrs or fine not exceeding 200.000 haht

* Whosoever, by du under this Act, ob TS which should b kept confidential, discloses such fact Whosoever, by duty under this Act, obtain TS which should be discloses such facts (except disclosure on duty or during investigation)

> -Imprison not exceeding I yr or fine not exceeding 100,000

Summary

- Only few cases regarding TS have been brought to Thai Court
- The Court orders dismissal because plaintiff cannot prove the threshold of the law
- Confidential clauses or confidentiality agreement are seldom use in business contract
