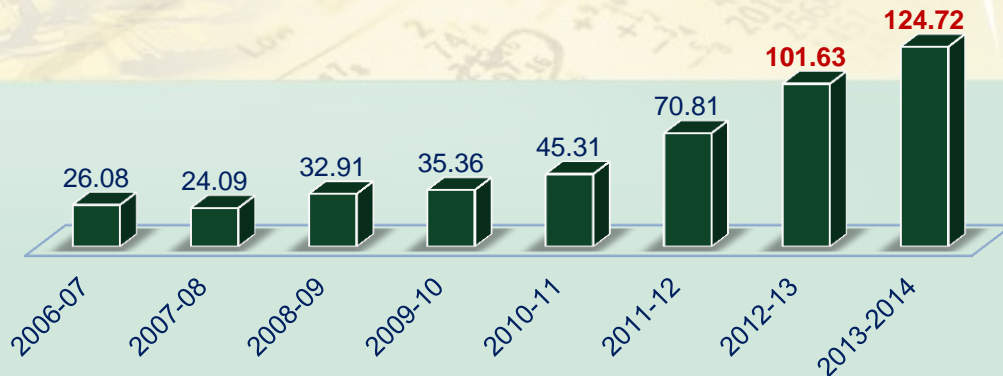

■ Export (in million USD)

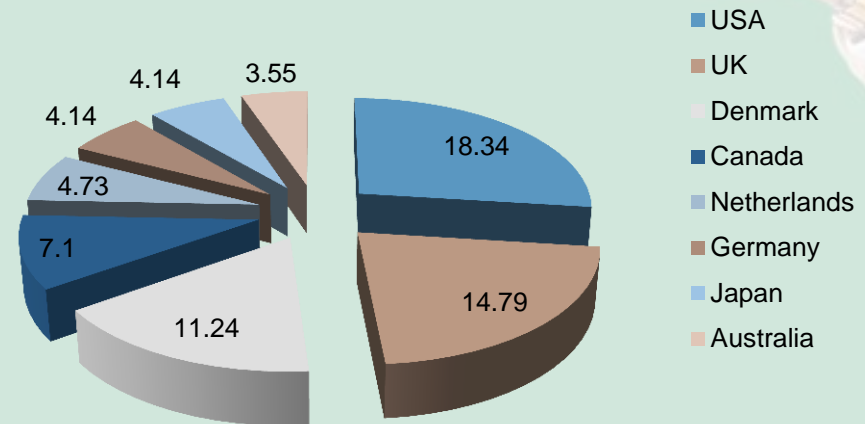

Major Export in Japan, USA & Europe

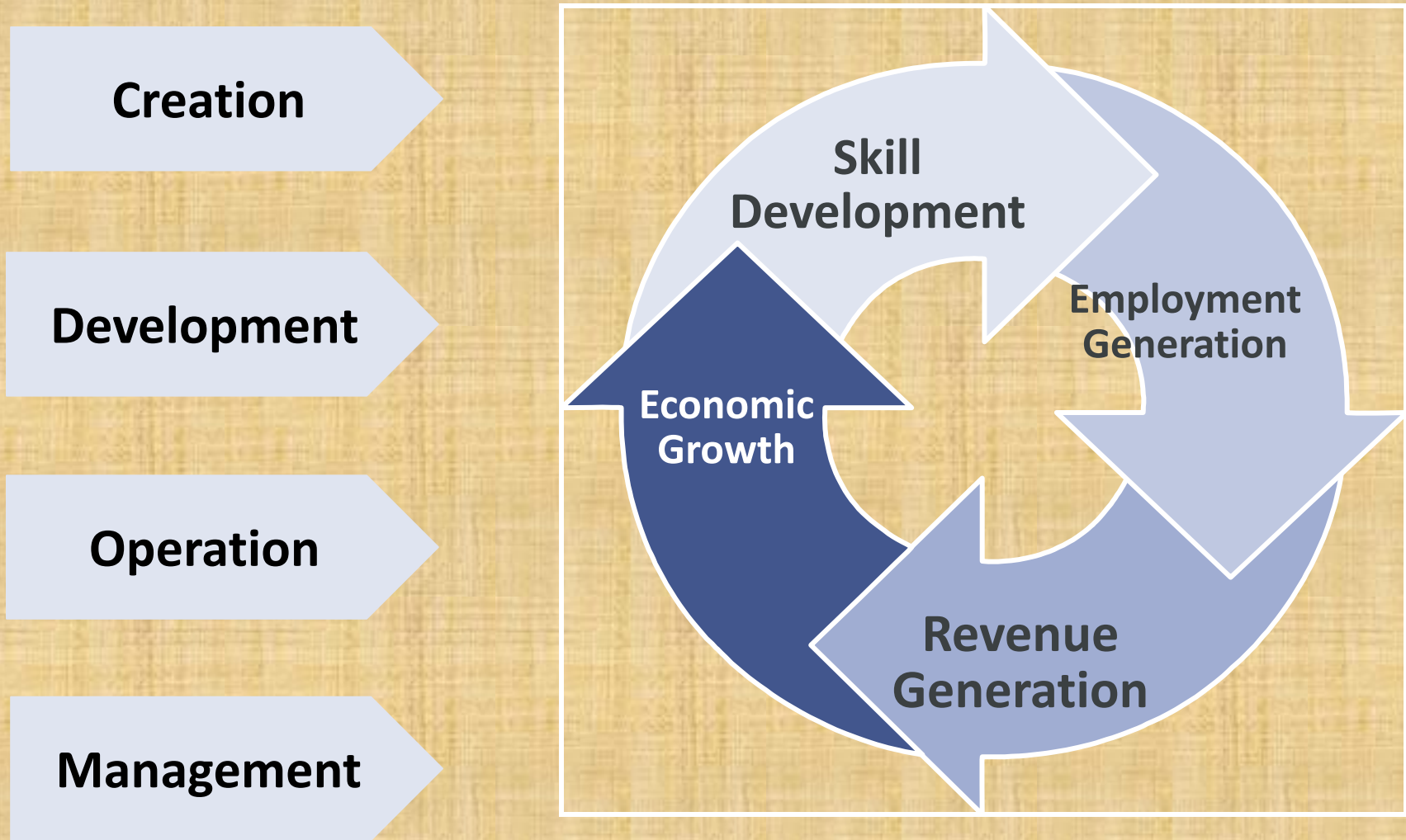
(Percentage of Companies Exporting)

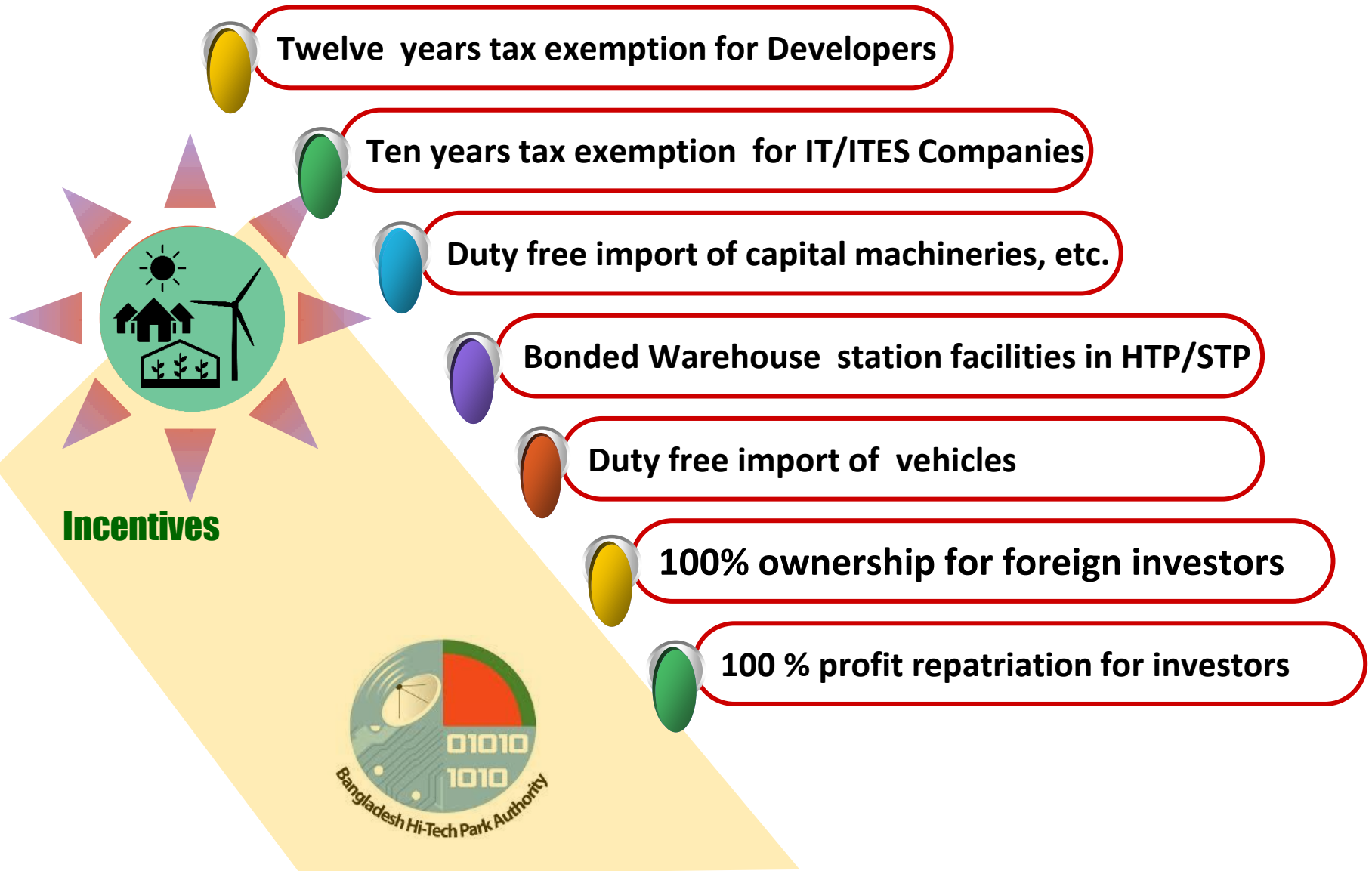

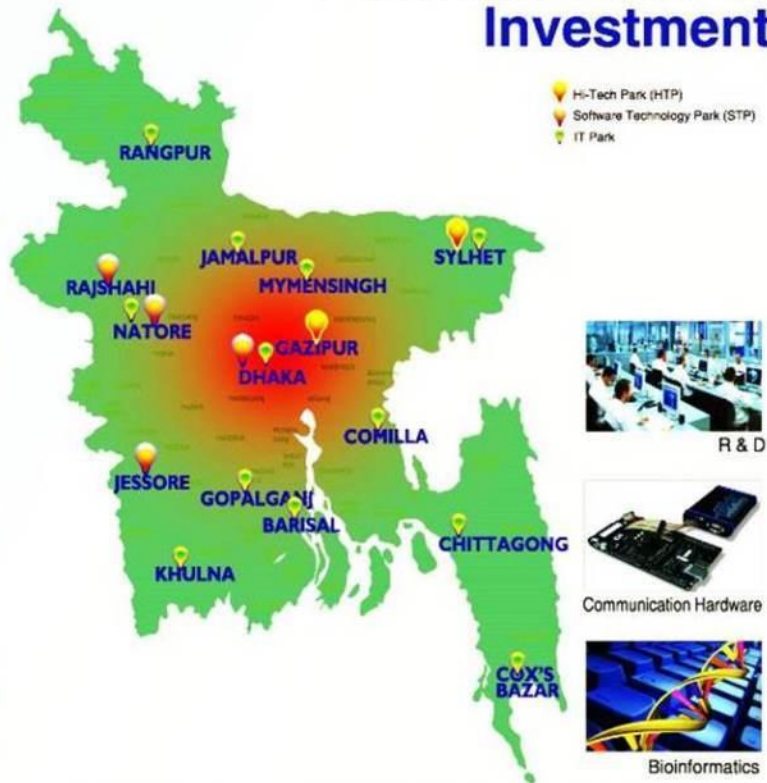
