I am directed to invite your attention to the references cited.

2. In this connection I am to state that Inter-State 'to and fro' movement of workers and executives engaged in Industrial and other economic activities across the borders to the State of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala and Pondicherry shall be permitted without need of testing and quarantine in case

they come back from the destination in 48 hours. However any movement 'from or to' in containment zones may remain prohibited and this has to be done with mutual consent of both the District Administration. The Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency (TNeGA) shall make arrangements to provide e-passes for such cases.

3. I am also to request that the above instructions may be scrupulously followed.
