

Images that show usage of Japanese foods and ingredients in applied stores/restaurants.

- At least one picture, for the item that is selected on “2. Use of Japanese foods and ingredients” is required.
- The pictures must clearly show the use of food/ingredients produced in Japan.

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- Picture of a label/ carton box that identifies the origin as Japan.
- Picture of a menu displaying “xx from xx city, Japan” .

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- Pictures of stake, sushi, etc., that don't identify its origin as Japan.
- Pictures of products on a shelf that don't show their origin and don't specify they were made in Japan.

<Notice>

- In the case of wagyu, please submit images that proves it was produced in Japan. For example, the label of origin, etc.
- Japanese foods are defined as agricultural, forestry, and fishery products that are produced within Japan.
- Japanese alcoholic beverages are defined as alcoholic beverages that are produced within Japan.
- Even if the brand was originally established in Japan, it is not categorized as a Japanese food/ingredient IF the manufacturing site for the product is outside of Japan.
- × A spice that is sold in Japan and known as a Japanese brand, but its production site is in China.
