



ASEAN SELF CERTIFICATION ASEAN WIDE SELF CERTIFICATION (AWSC)



Can be utilized by exporters who have been certified by the Competent Authority (Ministry of Trade of the Republic of Indonesia).

Certified Exporter (CE) makes out Origin Declaration for its goods provided such goods meet ROO-ATIGA criteria.

Gives Indonesian exporters more options to:

- Use the Declaration of Origin
- Both e-Form D and paper-based Form D still be valid options



LEGAL FRAMEWORK ASEAN WIDE SELF CERTIFICATION (AWSC)

- The First Protocol to amend the ATIGA as the legal basis for the AWSC implementation framework, signed on January 22, 2019 in Hanoi, Viet Nam.
- Presidential Regulation No. 84 of 2020 concerning Ratification of the First Protocol to Amend the ATIGA which was promulgated on 27 July 2020.
- Minister of Trade Regulation Number 111 of 2018 concerning Provisions and Procedures for Issuance an Origin Declaration for Exported Goods from Indonesia
- Minister of Trade Regulation Number 71 of 2020 concerning Rules of Origin of Indonesia and Provisions for the Issuance a Documents of Origin of Indonesian Goods in the ASEAN Trade In Goods Agreement.

MINISTRY OF TRADE

Hard Copy of CO - FORM D

- Issued on the original CO Form Form D.
- Can use Affixed Signature and Stamp (ASnS), that is printed signature and stamp of regional issuing officials in electronic format.
- Equipped with Barcode and QR Code as well as e-verification facilities to prove the legality of COO

e-Form D (electronic CO)

- Indonesia has implemented e-Form D since February 1, 2020 to all ASEAN member countries
- E-Form D in e-SKA system is sent electronically and automatically to INSW portal and forwarded to ASW

Origin
Declaration on

- It has been implemented since September 20, 2020
- Can be utilized by exporters who are registered as ES/CE
- Exporters can produce a Declaration of Origin of Goods

Both e-Form D and paper-based Form D are still in use once the exporter registered as Certified Exporter. These proofs of origin will be used mostly by exporters who have not obtained CE status and may still be used by CEs if they prefer.





Registration of Certified Exporters (ES)

In accordance with the Minister of Trade Regulation No. 111 of 2018

MINISTRY OF TRAPE Certified Exporters (ES) are Regitered Exporter (ER) that have met the criteria for establishing a Certified Exporter and ROO Conditions, and are authorized by the Ministry of Trade to issue an Origin Declaration for exported goods to ASEAN country.



Criteria:

- Manufacturer and/or Trader who registered as ER
- Have a good export regulation compliance.
- Has a good bookkeeping and record keeping system
- No record of any trade sector fraud



Procedure:

registered process is through the e-SKA system

by filling data of 6 digits HS Code & description of goods

verification process are usually by document checking or verification visit



Supporting Documents:

Original scanned documents:

- 1. 3 name & specimen of DOO Signatories
- 2. Cost structure/Bill of **Materials**



Validity of Certification is 4 years after the stated date of determination.

Can be extended, data and information modification are allowed







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Certified Exporter Obligations

In accordance with the Minister of Trade Regulation No. 111 of 2018

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Submit at any time, all documents proving the status of origin of goods at the request of the Competent Authority (CA).



ES must be responsible for goods that are exported using the document of origin of the goods.




Receiving verification, from the CA on proving the origin of the goods



Keep documents of the origin of raw materials, export and import document, and commercial accounting records for manufactured goods for a minimum of 4 years




Notify the Competent Authority of changes affecting its registration data.





ORIGIN DECLARATION



Origin Declaration

To be able to use Origin Declaration ATIGA, exporters must be registered as Certified Exporters (CE) through e-SKA system.

Legal Status & Function of Origin Declaration

Origin Declaration has the same legal force and function as Form D and e-Form D.


Origin Declaration

Origin Declaration cannot be used simultaneously with Form D or e-Form D for the same goods in 1 (one) Export transaction




ORIGIN DECLARATION

- Origin Declaration is generated through the e-SKA system by a Certified Exporter (in invoice, packing list, or other commercial documents) which will be used as the basis for granting Preferential Tariff.
- Origin Declaration could be processed in the time of exportation or when CE decided to export.
- Origin Declaration valid for 12 (twelve) months after it was issued.
