


The NPP should become a customer-oriented, competence and expertise center for business, stimulating the development of strong national and regional industry associations

On January 12, 2024, a business forum and B2B meetings were held in Kazakhstan as part of the visit of the Japanese business delegation, focusing on the development of cooperation in the priority areas of GX (Green Transformation) and DX (Digital Transformation).







On August 9, 2024, the first «C5+Japan» Business Forum was held in Astana, bringing together representatives from the five Central Asian states and over 100 leading Japanese companies and organizations operating in key economic sectors.







On June 28, 2024, in Astana, the Business Council and Business Forum of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) were organized and held with the participation of SCO member states, members of the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the diplomatic corps, and more than 150 business representatives.
