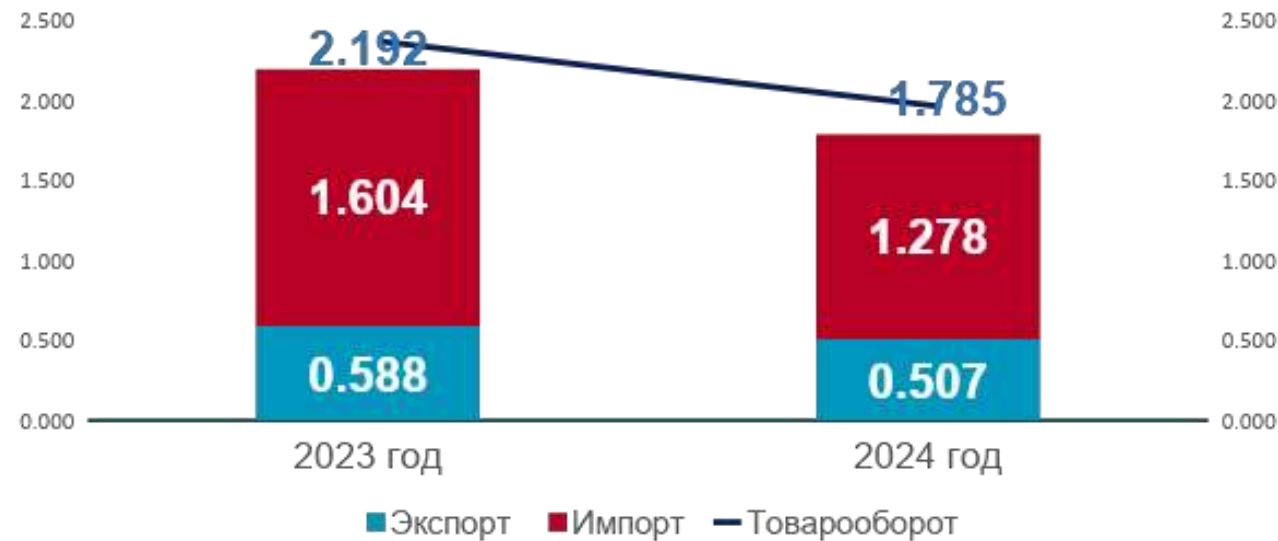

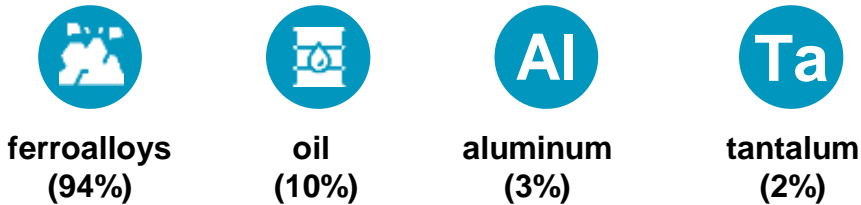
Trade turnover between Kazakhstan and Japan

Developed transport and communication infrastructure

Transport

There are 24 airports (72 air corridors) in the country.
Kazakhstan accounts for 70% of all transit land traffic between China and Europe.

Fast cargo transportation

Western Europe - Western China.
Transcontinental highway, delivery in 10 days.
Aktau and Kuryk seaports. The total capacity of the ports exceeds 27 million tons.

Telecommunications

Kazakhstan has the best telecommunications infrastructure, with 77% Internet penetration.

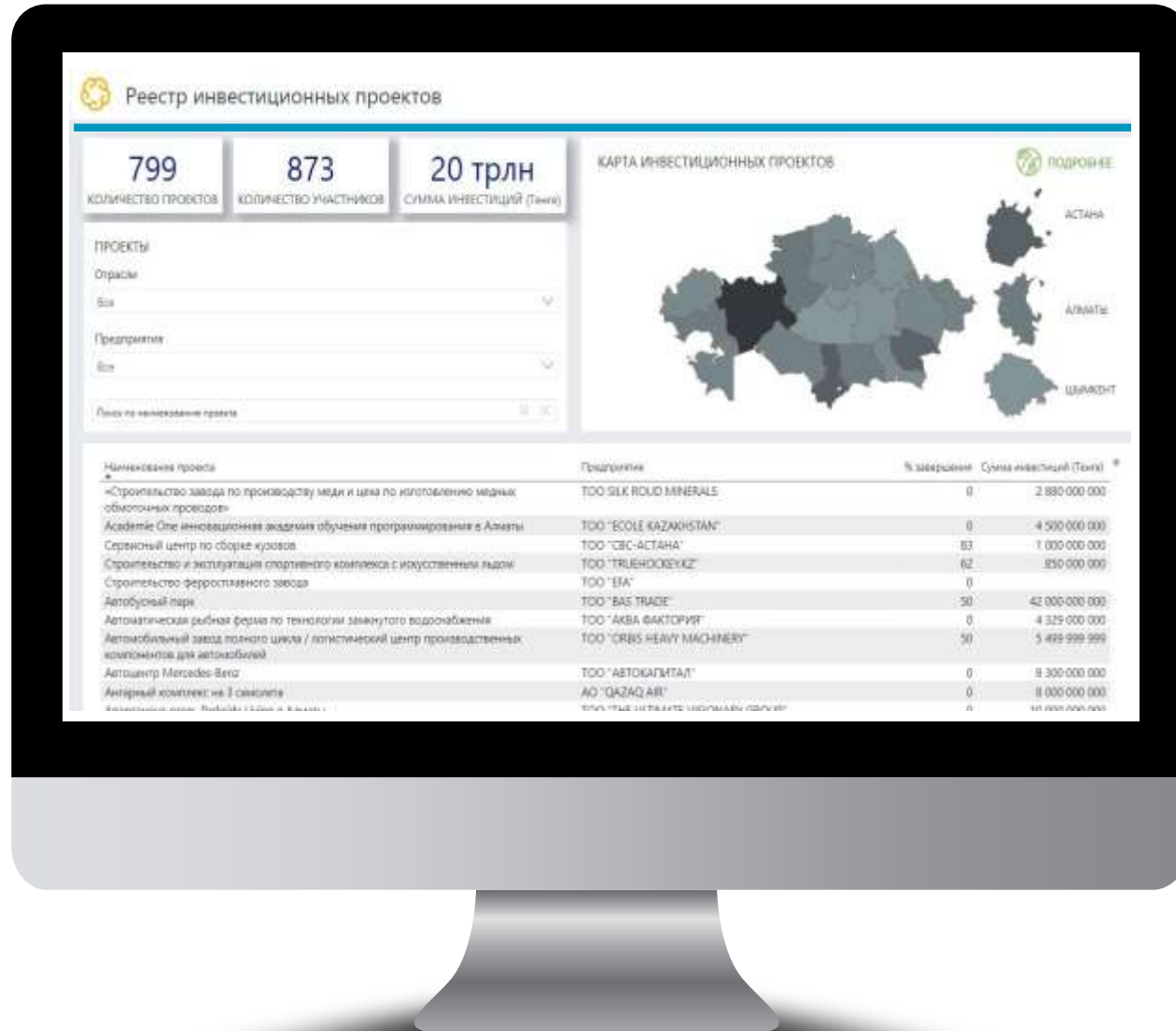
