## 1.0

### **Macroeconomic Performance**

The economy expanded by 5.0 per cent in the second guarter of 2025 compared to a growth of 4.6 per cent in the corresponding quarter of 2024. The growth was mainly supported by growths in Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing activities (4.4%), Transportation and Storage (5.4%) and Financial and Insurance (6.6%). The growth was also supported by rebounds in Construction and Mining and Quarrying activities that rose by 5.7 and 15.3 per cent, respectively, after contracting in the second quarter of 2024. Electricity and water supply activities also recorded improved performance in the quarter under

review, posting a growth of 5.7 per cent compared to 1.2 per cent growth in the second guarter of 2024.


In the second quarter of 2025, the Gross Value Added (GVA) for agricultural activities recorded a slight deceleration compared to the corresponding quarter of 2024. Nonetheless, favourable weather conditions continued to support both crop and animal production during the review period.


Figure 1: Second Quarter GDP Growth Rates (%), 2021-2025



The quarter under review recorded improved performance in most of the key macroeconomic indicators. The average inflation for the second quarter of 2025 eased to 3.89 per cent from an average of 4.87 per cent in a similar quarter of 2024 on account of lower prices of food and non-alcoholic beverages.


Figure 2: Inflation Rates, 2021-2025

Figure 2 shows the average inflation rate trend from 2021 to 2025.

During the quarter under review, the Kenyan Shilling strengthened against the US Dollar by 1.2 per cent. In contrast, the Kenyan Shilling weakened against other major international currencies, including the Japanese Yen, the Pound Sterling, and the Euro, by 6.5 per cent,

4.5 per cent, and 4.0 per cent, respectively. Regionally, the Kenyan Shilling weakened against the Ugandan Shilling and the South African Rand by 2.7 per cent and 0.5 per cent, respectively, but appreciated against the Tanzanian Shilling in the review period.

During the period under review, the Central Bank Rate (CBR) was lowered to 10.00 per cent for both April and May 2025 and further to 9.75 per cent in June 2025 compared to 13.00 per cent in June 2024. The Broad money supply (M3) rose by 8.1 per cent in the second quarter of 2025 to stand at KSh 6,450.1 billion at the end of June 2025. Similarly, the NSE 20 Share Index rose from 1656.5 points in June 2024 to stand at 2440.3 points in June 2025, representing a 47.0 per cent growth.

The current account balance widened from a deficit of KSh 47.4 billion in the second quarter of 2024 compared to KSh 83.7 billion in the second quarter of 2025.

### 2.0 **Sectoral Analysis**

### **Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing**

Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing activities recorded a growth of 4.4 per cent in the second quarter of 2025 compared to 4.5 per cent growth in the corresponding quarter of 2024. This growth was on account of increased production of coffee, vegetables, fruits, cut flower and milk.

In the second quarter of 2025, coffee exports rose by 26.0 per cent to 20,041.7 metric tonnes. Exports of fruit and vegetables also increased from 72,124.8 metric tonnes and 14,194.5 metric tonnes in the second quarter of 2024 to 79,431.8 metric tonnes and 18,672.8 metric tonnes, respectively, in the period under review. Similarly, cut flower exports increased by 33.1 per cent to stand at 32,493.5 metric tonnes in the second quarter of 2025. Milk intake by processors grew by 24.1 per cent, from 219.2 million litres in the second quarter of 2024 to 272.0 million litres in the quarter under review.

However, cane deliveries declined from 2,269.3 thousand metric tonnes in the second guarter of 2024 to 1,259.4 thousand metric tonnes in the period under review. Tea production also declined by 5.3 per cent from 154.5 thousand metric tonnes in the second guarter of 2024 to stand at 146.3 thousand metric tonnes in the second quarter of 2025.





Manufacturing sector's real GDP expanded by 1.0 per cent in the second quarter of 2025 compared to a growth of 3.2 per cent in the corresponding quarter of 2024.

### Manufacturing

Manufacturing sector's real GDP expanded by 1.0 per cent in the second guarter of 2025 compared to a growth of 3.2 per cent in the corresponding quarter of 2024. Activities in the manufacture of food

sub-sector recorded mixed per-

formances during the review period. Milk delivered to processors increased significantly by 24.1 per cent to 272.0 million litres from 219.2 million litres in the second quarter of 2024. Production of soft drinks declined by 6.7 per cent to 143.9 million litres in the period under review. Similarly, sugar production contracted by 43.8 per cent to 107.3 thousand metric tonnes from 191.0 thousand metric tonnes in the second quarter of 2024 Tea production declined by 5.3 per cent to 146.3 thousand metric tonnes during the review period.

The non-food manufacturing activities posted varied growths. Cement production increased by 21.0 per cent to 2,469.7 thousand metric tonnes in the second quarter of 2025 compared to 2,040.4 thousand metric tonnes in the same quarter of 2024. Production of galvanised sheets rose by 11.3 per cent to 77.2 thousand metric tonnes in the review quarter. Similarly, assembly of motor vehicles expanded by 20.8 per cent to 3,350 units compared to 2,773 units assembled in the second quarter of 2024. Credit advanced to enterprises in the manufacturing sector increased from KSh 581.1 billion as at June 2024 to KSh 598.3 billion as at June 2025.

### **Electricity Supply**

During the period under review, electricity and water supply

During the period under review, electricity and water supply sector grew by 5.7 per cent up from 1.2 per cent recorded in a similar quarter of 2024.

sector grew by 5.7 per cent up from 1.2 per cent recorded in a similar quarter of 2024. Total electricity sales grew by 15.2 per cent, reaching 3,054.9 million kWh in

the second quarter of 2025, up from 2,650.7 million kWh sold during the same period in 2024.

The growth was largely supported by increased electricity generation, which rose by 7.5 per cent to 3,270.0-million-kilowatt hour (kWh) during the second guarter of 2025 compared to 3,041.5 million kWh generated in the same period in 2024. Electricity generated from geothermal grew from 1,279.3 million kWh during the second guarter of 2024 to 1,479.8 million kWh in the quarter under review. Similarly, electricity generated from wind increased by 23.6 per cent to stand at 413.8 million kWh in the guarter under review. Thermal electricity generation increased by 24.6 per cent, to stand at 344.3 million kWh up from 276.5 million kWh recorded in the second quarter of 2024.

However, the sector's growth was curtailed by decline in hydro and solar electricity generation. Hydro generated electricity decreased to 919.6 million kWh during the second quarter of 2025, down from 1,036.5 million kWh in the corresponding guarter of 2024. Similarly, solar electricity generation decreased to 112.5 million kWh in the second guarter of 2025 from 114.4 million kWh in the same quarter of 2024.

### Construction

Construction sector activities grew by 5.7 per cent in the review period compared to a 3.7 per cent contraction in the second quarter of 2024. The sector's performance was man-

materials. During the second quarter of 2025, cement consumption increased by 23.9 per cent to stand at 2,424.4 thousand metric tonnes from 1,957.1 thousand metric tonnes in the corresponding period of 2024. Similarly, the quantity of imported bitumen increased to 22,659.3 metric tonnes, up from 15,566.2 metric tonnes imported during the corresponding quarter of 2024. Furthermore, iron and steel imports increased to

stand at 526,606.4 metric tonnes in the quarter under review compared to 222,112.3 metric tonnes imported in a similar quarter of 2024. Credit extended to enterprises in the construction sector grew by 21.7 per cent to stand at KSh 159.6 billion as at June 2025, compared to KSh 131.1 billion as at the same period in 2024.

### **Transportation and Storage**

Transportation and Storage sector is estimated to have expanded by 5.4 per cent in the second quarter of

Transportation and Storage sector is estimated to have expanded by 5.4 per cent in the second quarter of 2025 compared to 3.4 per cent in the corresponding quarter of 2024. The performance was supported by increased activity in land transport, railway operations and port throughput.

Consumption of light diesel, which is a key input in passenger and freight road transport, rose by 12.0 per cent to 580.8 thousand metric tonnes from 518.6 thousand metric tonnes in the second quarter of 2024. The number of passengers transported via Standard Gauge Railway (SGR) increased by 10.3 per cent to 658.6 thousand passengers in the review quarter, while the volume of cargo transported via SGR grew by 8.7 per cent to 1,894.4 thousand metric tonnes.

Port activities remained vibrant during the review period, with Mombasa Port throughput increasing by 4.0 per cent to 10,730.4 thousand metric tonnes in the second quarter of 2024 partly driven by improved performance of Liquid Bulk, Dry Bulk and Loose Cargo. International passenger arrivals through JKIA and MIA rose by 3.3 per cent from 828,884 passengers in the second guarter of 2024 to 856,347 passengers in the review period. Additionally, international departures increased by 7.3 per cent from 824,640 passengers in the second quarter of 2024 to 885,139 passengers in the second quarter of 2025. However, domestic arrivals via JKIA and MIA declined by 7.5 per cent from 370,138 passengers in the second quarter of 2024 to 342,244 passengers in a similar quarter of 2025. Similarly, domestic departures through JKIA and MIA declined from 364,120 passengers

in the second quarter of 2024 to 309,920 passengers in the second quarter of 2025.

### Accommodation and Food Service **Activities**

Accommodation and Food Service activities experienced slower growth in the second quarter of 2025 compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025. The sec-

tor grew by 7.8 per cent in the

quarter under review compared to a growth of 35.0 per cent in the second quarter of 2024. The number of international visitor arrivals via the two major airports, the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) and Mombasa International Airport (MIA) rose by 3.5 per cent in the second quarter of 2025 compared to a 15.4 per cent increase recorded in the second guarter of 2024.


### Information and Communication **Activities**

Activities in the Information and Communication sector grew by 6.0 per cent in the second quarter of 2025 compared to 6.7 per cent growth in the similar quarter of 2024. Total domestic mobile voice traffic increased by 17.3 per cent in the second guarter of 2025, to 29.2 billion minutes, compared to 24.9 billion minutes in the corresponding quarter of 2024. International mobile voice traffic increased by 24.3 per cent to stand at 367.5 million minutes in the quarter under review. Over the same period, total mobile broadband data consumption rose by 38.4 per cent from 448.2 million GB in the second quarter of 2024 to 620.2 million GB in a similar quarter of 2025 indicating not only an expanding subscriber base but also higher

average data usage per user. In contrast, the total value of mobile money transactions declined by 1.4 per cent to KSh 2.08 trillion in the reviewing period, from KSh 2.11 trillion in the corresponding quarter of 2024.



Activities in the Information and Communication sector grew by 6.0 per cent in the second quarter of 2025 compared to 6.7 per cent growth in the similar quarter of 2024.





### **Financial and Insurance Activities**

Financial and Insurance sector grew by 6.6 per cent in the second guarter of 2025 compared to 8.0 per cent in the corresponding quarter of 2024. The Central Bank Rate was revised downwards from 13.00 per cent in June 2024 to 9.75 per cent in June 2025 to stimulate lending to private sector and support economic activity. The cost of credit eased during the second quarter of 2025, with average interest rates on loans and other advances by commercial banks declining to 15.29 per cent in June 2025 from 16.85 per cent in June 2024. The inter-bank rate declined from 13.14 per cent in June 2024 to 9.72 per cent in June 2025. The average yield for 91 Days Treasury Bills stood at 8.21 per cent in June 2025 from 15.97 per cent in June 2024.

Broad money supply (M3) grew by 8.1 per cent to KSh 6,450.1 billion as at end of June 2025 from KSh 5,965.6 billion as at June 2024 on account of growth in demand and quasi monetary deposits. Net foreign assets (NFA) grew by 18.0 per cent from KSh 910.5 billion in June 2024 to KSh 1,074.0 billion as at end of June 2025. The increase in net foreign assets was on account of foreign asset holdings of the Central Bank of Kenya which increased by 42.1 per cent to KSh 1,499.4 billion in June 2025.

Total domestic credit registered a growth of 10.5 per cent from KSh 6,837.3 billion in June 2024 to KSh 7,557.8 billion in June 2025. This growth was supported by improved credit to private sector and total net lending to

Government which expanded by by 4.4 per cent and 26.2 per cent, respectively, over the review period. Credit advanced to County Governments increased from KSh 6.6 billion in June 2024 to KSh 16.1 billion in June 2025.





Figure 4: Domestic credit, January 2023 to June 2025, billion

The number of shares traded in the Nairobi Securities Exchange more than doubled from 279 million in June 2024 to 580 million in June 2025. Correspondingly, the total value of shares traded increased from KSh 5.0 billion

in June 2024 to KSh 12.0 billion in June 2025. The NSE 20 Share Index increased from 1,656.5 points in June 2024 to 2,440.3 points in June 2025.


